

THE RENOVATIONS AND RELOCATION OF SWANSEA ONLINE ACCESS CENTRE.

On 4th December 2020 I was approached by the Department of Education (DoE) about SOAC relocating so that the area that we were occupying at Swansea Primary School (SPS) could be used by SPS for special needs students.

DoE advised that they had found a space in the old Glamorgan Municipality Building in Noyes St. and that a meeting had been arranged for Thursday 16th December for inspection of the facilities. We arrived to find, that no only were DoE & Glamorgan Spring Bay Council (GSBC) present, but the Management Committee of the Court hose were present. The room was full of stored items from the museum and could not be properly inspected.

Because of the stored items, SOAC asked that the room be cleared so as to ascertain the future suitability of the premises, for our use. After the inspection of the cleared room, we were asked by DoE to draw up a "Mud Plan" of the room for our fit out and development.

Substantial & costly renovation and repairs to the building would have been required to bring the building to a habitable standard including restumping and installation of all abilities restroom.

After reviewing the costings, GSBC de-

cided that the cost was too great and offered SOAC the old "Visitor Information Centre's" space in the museum building. This space was approximately 10 sq, and would require some work to enable All Abilities access. This would further reduce the usable space for SOAC's needs.

For this reason and due to other conditions being imposed on SOAC, we decided that we were not happy with this offer and that we would not be proceeding further with GSBC's facilities. This occurred in May 2021.

In August of that year, DoE came up with a proposal that we would share a space in a renovated library.

Over the next 2 years meetings were held between DoE, SPS & SOAC until a final floor plan was agreed upon between the parties.

In April 2023 Expression of Interest were called for the construction and renovation of the area. The successful quote was accepted in July 2023, Prework was to be carried out from approx. mid-July with work to be commenced at the end of July.

The works commenced on 1st August. However it was delayed for 4 weeks due to the discovery of asbestos in the building. After this material was safely and correctly removed, construction continued apace.

In the week beginning 11th December, the Certificates of Occupancy were issued and the renovated Library area including SOAC were available to be utilised.

We would like at this stage to acknowledge & thank Freycinet Volunteer Marine Rescue for allowing us to use their boatshed and the Terry Charlton Room to enable us to print the newsletter on a weekly basis, as we believe that it is imperative that the newsletter be printing.

On Monday 8th January, SOAC began utilising the space allocated. Please bear

with us as we believe that there may be some teething problems, which need to be tackled as & when they arise.

Unfortunately this has to await the return to school of the staff involved in the redevelopment

SOAC struggles to remain relevant, as do many Online Access Centres, in our small town while the GOBCNews is like so many small businesses, how to make ends meet with major reductions in advertising revenue and ever increasing printing costs.

As a result of this situation the SOAC Committee may be forced to make some major changes to both SOAC and the GOBCNews to ensure their future continuation.

The Committee will keep the community informed of these possible changes.






