RESCUE OFF DOLPHIN SANDS

Emergency services were out in force at Jubilee Beach boat ramp on the afternoon of Saturday 22nd January. At 2:15pm a Freycinet Volunteer Marine Rescue crew was called to respond to a report of three kayakers in trouble off Dolphin Sands. Also responding were the Police rescue helicopter, a 'rubber ducky' crew from Bicheno Surf Life Saving Club, Wineglass Bay Cruises' *Schouten Passage II* and two recreational fishing boats. 40 minutes later a lone kayaker was simultaneously sighted by *Schouten Passage II* and VMR's *Freycinet Lodge Rescue*. The kayak fisherman was nearly 1km off Nine Mile Beach, clinging to his kayak which had partially filled with water and was floating vertically with just the forward part of kayak above the water. He confirmed that he was alone. It's thought that fishing equipment, fitted to the kayak, including an electric outboard motor, may have been taken as additional people on the kayak when seen from a distance.

With the kayak in tow, the kayaker was transported back to Jubilee Beach where he was assessed by Ambulance Tasmania. Thanks go to whoever saw this situation developing and reported it to Tasmania Police. Thanks also to the other vessels who responded.

This was the second incident this month where recreational boaters have assisted in an emergency. On New Years Day a jetski, with two people on board, was reported sinking off Hepburn Point, between Swanwick and Coles Bay. *Lisa's Luck* heard our call on marine radio for anyone in the area able to assist and was alongside the partially submerged jetski within 10 minutes.

If you become aware of a life-threatening emergency on the water call Triple Zero. For assistance when lives are not immediately in danger, e.g. a breakdown, call the Police Assistance Line on 131 444. If you're out boating or kayaking wear a life-jacket. If you have a marine VHF radio on board, listen out on Channel 16. Stay safe, on land, and on the water.

RISING COSTS HIT TASMANIANS HARD

New figures out today show Tasmanians continue to suffer under rising prices, with cost of living increases now significantly outpacing wages growth.

Shadow Treasurer Shane Broad said the latest CPI data shows Hobart has the high-

est quarterly inflation of any capital city and the highest rate here since 2000.

"Today's figures confirm what thousands of Tasmanians already know – that they are struggling under the weight of ever-rising prices and stagnated wages growth," Dr Broad said.

"Hobart has the highest quarterly inflation rate of any capital city – at 2.2 per cent – compared to the national average of 1.3 per cent.

"Annual inflation is now running at 4.5 per cent, well above the national rate of 3.5 per cent, with cost of living increases now the highest they've been in 20 years.

"With the most recent wage growth figures at 2.7 per cent in the year to September, cost of living increases are now significantly outpacing wages growth.

"Among the key areas affected, electricity prices rose by 16 per cent in the quarter, fuel by 12.4 per cent, utilities by 9.3 per cent, housing by 5.5 per cent and transport 5.2 per cent.

"So despite all the bragging by this government about how well the state is doing, the reality for far too many Tasmanians is very different, with State Government decisions on water pricing, broken promises on fuel pricing and failures on housing only adding to the pain.

"And it's not just Tasmanian families and individuals who are hurting – the Liberals may be spruiking CommSec's January State of the State Report, but the fact is that the report has assessed the results for the last quarter, before the borders reopened.

"Since then, businesses have had to deal with a big downturn from the COVID outbreak while also being slugged with increases in fixed costs like electricity.

"All of this adds up to a world of pain for Tasmanian families, businesses and individuals. No amount of spinning the numbers in the Liberals' favour will change that."

To the editorial team

THE ONGOING SAGA OF GSBC SUSTAINABILITY.....

I read with interest the piece in the 1st edition for 2022 from GSBC, and as a consequence read the three pieces referred to on the Councils website, endeavouring to explain the background to the future financial planning of the Council, and it's sustainability.

I was particularly interested to read that the Mayor said Council were going "on to the front foot about information as to the need for rate increases". Accordingly, I wrote to the Mayor on the 15th December 2021 as follows:-

" As I mentioned in previous correspondence, my wife and I are self funded independent retirees with limited income. I need to be in a position where I can reasonably accurately know the cash outflow positions which we are going to be asked to meet during the next twelve months. Accordingly, as the Chairman of Councillors of the GSBC, I ask you to in dollar terms please advise me what municipal rates your Council proposes to levy on our property (as addressed above) for the 2022/2023 year? "

Later on that day, I received the following response from the Mayor:-

"Dear Mr Gaunt

I cannot state what council will levy next year.

Council has not decided upon the matter. It is likely that there will be an increase. Our state Government grants will reduce because the properties in this municipality have increased in value.

Part of the answer to your query depends upon what other revenue council can obtain from its other sources of income. I like others have received a rate increase.

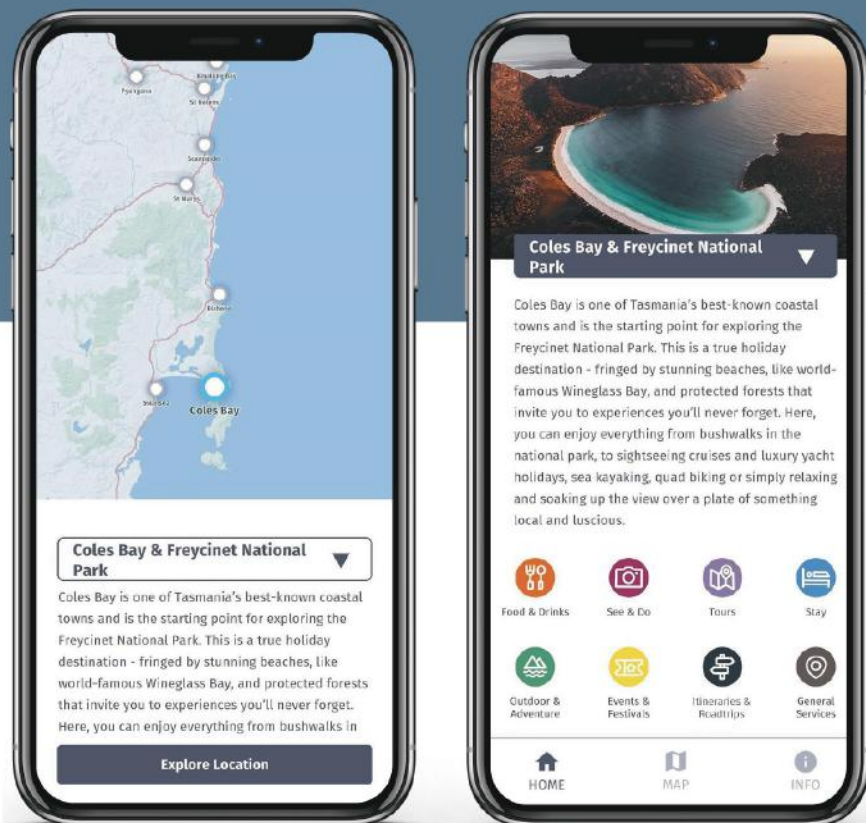

AERIAL FIRE- FIGHTING FLEET BOLSTERED

Tasmania's firefighting capacity has been bolstered with the launch of the summer aviation fleet to help keep Tasmanians safe from the threat of bushfires.

Tasmania now has 12 specialised aircraft on hand to help fight fires from above, including a mix of firebombing, air super-visibility and aerial intelligence gathering aircraft. Eight are helicopters and four are fixed wing planes. These aircraft are made possible through the collaboration of the Tasmanian and Australian Governments who jointly fund the aircraft through the National Aerial Firefighting Centre.

The fleet are all strategically positioned so that they can be moved quickly around the State to respond to fires.

In addition, 20 local aircraft are available to call on to assist when required, taking the total firefighting aircraft available in Tasmania to 32. This will ensure a rapid response to bushfires when they start, keeping fires small until ground crews arrive.

Tasmania is well prepared for the bushfire season, and we recognise the importance of having access to a sophisticated, flexible, aerial firefighting capability to respond to bushfires, protect our communities and to support firefighters on the ground.

The Tasmania Fire Service, Parks and Wildlife Service and Sustainable Timbers Tasmania have been busy preparing for, and responding to bushfires over the last month.

We know that investing in the aerial firefighting fleet is a critical part of keeping Tasmanians safe during bushfire season.

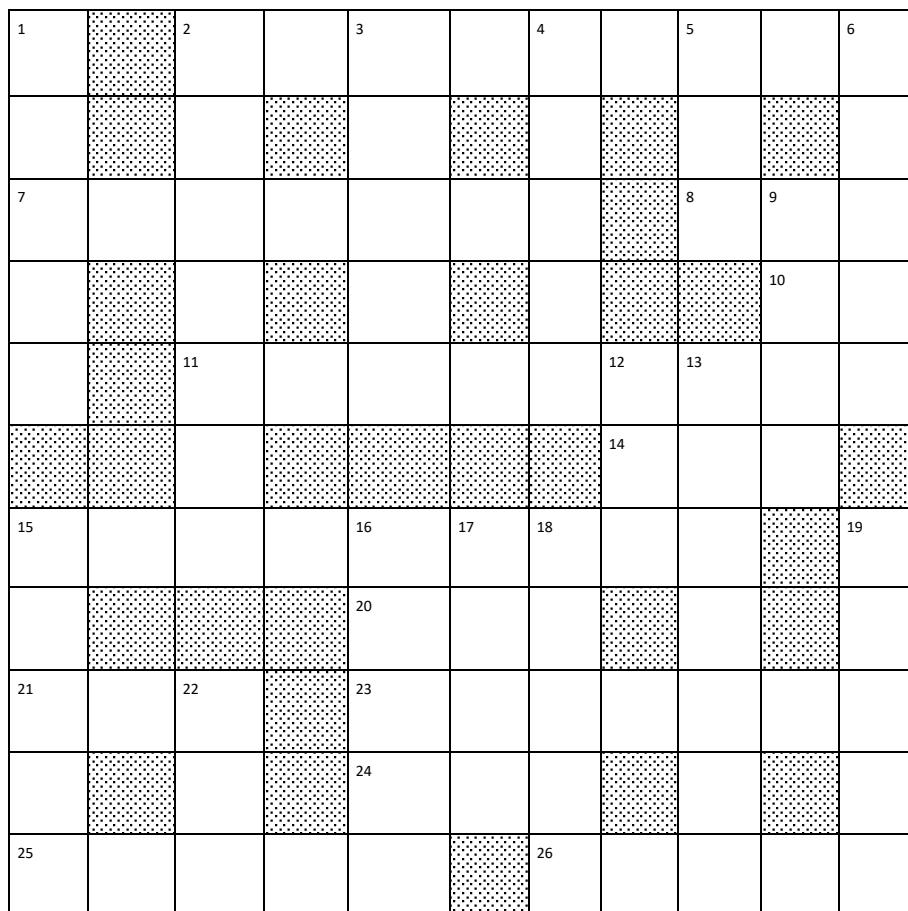
