MAYORAL MOMENTS FOR JANUARY -

The past month has been incredibly busy for the newly elected Council. The learning curve remains very high even for returning Councillors but I am pleased to report that every councillor has grasped the opportunity given them by the electors of our wonderful area to represent the community in the Council Chamber.

The first Council meeting for 2023 provided an opportunity to support Rural Alive and Well and the Bicheno Surf Life Saving Club under the Community Small Grants Program. Both organisations provide a valuable service to our communities.

Staff have been progressively working through various Asset Management Plans (AMP) that will drive our budget discussions. The Hydraulic Infrastructure AMP presented at this meeting was deferred as some Councillors required further information. The Hydraulic Infrastructure AMP will now be further workshopped next month to enable Council to get some clarity around the changes to the hydraulic infrastructure asset value and future costs.

A review of the 2022/23 budget was presented to this meeting due to some additional income received and Council's monitoring of our financial situation. Staff are preparing a communication strategy to provide community input into the 2023/24 budget discussions. It is important for Council to learn what the community's vision is for the upcoming year so please take every opportunity to participate in the consultation process that will commence in early April.

Three development applications were presented (DA's) that required a council decision as opposed to planning staff making the decision due to the number of representations received. Council's delegation to planning staff allows them to formally approve (or refuse) a DA when 2 or less representations are received.

Two of the development applications were approved with conditions and one was refused. It should be noted that the Swansea development at 10c Franklin Street that was refused was accepted by a majority of Councillors as an exciting project for the area except for the height and bulk of the building and the overall effect on the amenity of the town. It was agreed that the assessment that was done against the provisions of the planning scheme was appropriate and as such a refusal motion was the only option. The developer has indicated a willingness to work with Council and mediate on the proposal with planning staff.






