

LOCAL BUSINESSES SUFFERING FROM STAFF SHORTAGES

Some East Coast business are being forced to reduce opening hours or closing on days when their staff are unavailable for their shifts. Many businesses are unable to achieve their full potential due to these staff shortage.

Employers in the hospitality industry are finding it difficult to find staff that are able or willing to do the long hours associated with the industry. Particularly hit hard are businesses that require staff that have both early morning and/or late-night opening times.

"Locals" are usually not willing to commit to working full hours in hospitality due to the fact that part time casual jobs are a better and more flexible alternative to the temporary seasonal work of restaurants. Better to be working 4-5 hours, 3 days a week all year, than only 3-4 months full time.

Businesses suffering from staff shortages include a local resort which has temporary ly closed its restaurant 2-3 days a week due to the lack of cooking staff, while a café has stopped serving hot food, in part due to lack of waiting staff and may have to soon close.

There are many different reasons for staff shortages but in the end the result is the same, less hours open, reduced earnings, more business closures. The trend will only continue and possibly worsen as East Coast populations age, pressure from increased tourism and fewer younger couples moving into the region.

Covid may be the current reason for the difficulties but the prob-

lem has persisted for years and will continue on the East Coast and other rural and regional areas well into the future.

Governments, which look only at the big population centres, are blind to the needs of regional areas and yet expect these regions to carry the burden of managing our biggest employer and biggest money spinner, the tourist trade.


# THE GET INTO IT - HEALTHY HEART HEALTHY MIND PROGRAM UPDATE FOR 2022.


