

AWARD TO LOCAL EMERGENCY SERVICES VOLUNTEER!

Our local Glamorgan Spring Bay Australia Day awards celebrate the achievements, dedication and sense of community in individuals from throughout our great municipality. This year the awards were held in Bicheno, with community members coming together to celebrate and acknowledge the contributions made by 3 outstanding individuals. Amy Quinn was acknowledged as the Young Citizen of the year, Citizen of the year Helen Gamble and Emergency Services volunteer of the year Ken Nichols. Congratulations to all the recipients.

Our focus now is a quick snap shot of our Local Swansea Fire Brigade Chief Ken Nichols. Ken has been an active volunteer with the Tasmanian Fire Service Swansea Brigade for over 27 year, holding key positions in the Brigade before becoming Brigade Chief in 2003. Ken received the Tasmania Fire Service Volunteers Medal in 2019 for diligent service to the Swansea Brigade.

He has been a stalwart of the Brigade capably leading our local volunteers thru many major fires including the Swan Inn, numerous vegetation fires at Dolphin Sands and the Bicheno fires.

Always available for callouts, to provide vital information to residents when asked or to check properties for proper fire safety. Assisting our residents with home fire safety including changing of smoke alarm batteries.

Ken was instrumental in the cats-eye property identification project adopted to identify water and turning areas at Dolphin Sands to assist responding brigades in property identification.

A mentor to all within the Brigade and the wider service his local knowledge is well sought after during incidents by all.



Tirelessly working behind the scene, providing equipment checks and maintenance, building and equipment upgrades, training and WH&S and much, much more.

We thank Ken for his community spirit and commitment to the local Swansea Fire Brigade and wider community.

The team has already been busy on the ground in the state and assisted last year's recovery effort in North-west Tasmania after the cyclonic wind event.

DRA helps Australian communities rebuild after disasters, such as floods, bushfires, and cyclones.

The organisation unites the skills and experiences of Australian Defence Force veterans, emergency responders and everyday Australians. It rapidly deploys disaster relief teams locally, nationally and around the globe to assist communities in need. With more than 2,500 volunteers, DRA has nine Disaster Relief Teams (DRTs) Australia-wide.

The Tasmanian DRT is the latest addition to the network and a welcome addition to Tasmania's local and national disaster relief efforts.







SWANSEA GENERAL PRACTICE 2023 COVID BOOSTER VACCINATION

A COVID booster vaccination is recommended if you HAVE NOT had COVID infection or a COVID vaccination in the past six months. We will be holding COVID and Influenza vaccination clinics together in March or April depending on when the vaccines become available to us. If you wish to travel and would like a COVID vaccination prior to these clinics, they will be available at pharmacies in Hobart and Launceston. We will not be taking bookings; we will advise the community of the dates for "Walk-in" clinics via the local newsletter.

A 2023 COVID-19 booster dose is **recommended** for:

- all adults aged 65 years and over
- adults aged 18 64 years who have medical conditions that increase their risk of severe COVID

A 2023 COVID-19 booster dose should also be **considered** (and will be available for) for:

- all Adults aged 18-64 years without risk factors for severe COVID-19
- children and adolescents aged 5-17 years who have medical conditions or disabilities that increase their risk of severe COVID

COVID booster doses are **not recommended** at this time for children and adolescents aged under the age of 18 who do not have any risk factors for severe COVID-19.

Medical conditions that increase the risk of severe COVID include (but are not limited to):

- Patients with chronic disability
- Patients on immune suppression medications
- Patients receiving treatment for cancer
- Patients with leukaemia

- Patients with a cancer diagnosed in the last 5 years
- Chronic kidney, heart, lung or liver disease
- Patients with diabetes
- Patients with neurological disease such as stroke or MS
- Patients with severe mental illness
- Overweight patients with BMI greater than 40

Remember, 2023 COVID booster is recommended ONLY if you haven't had a booster or a COVID infection in the past six months. If it has been less than 6 months it is recommended you wait until the full 6 months have passed before having this booster. There is no reason, however, to delay having your influenza vaccination.

Volunteers are deployed to communities post-disaster to assist with debris removal, home repairs, maintenance and provide safe, practical, and structured on-the-ground support.

DRA capabilities include incident management, damage and impact assessment, aerial damage assessment and mapping, work order management, spontaneous volunteer management as well as resilience and capacity building.

To date, DRA has deployed its volunteers to more than 25 disaster relief operations throughout Australia. It continues to grow and 2023 will be its busiest year yet with multiple recovery operations already underway in Victoria, NSW and potentially SA

Tasmania DRT Manager Scott Whiley said DRA the organisation has never needed people more.

He said: "DRA is a unique proposition. We put the experience, skills, and discipline of veterans and civilian counterparts

to practical use in communities that are experiencing their worst days. Tasmania fights well above its weight when it comes to military history and helping mates in distress."

He added: "Our veterans work alongside emergency services personnel and civilians and establish connections with people outside of the military and develop rapport with individuals and communities recovering from a disaster. We help communities and we help our volunteers."

DRA provides full volunteer training as well as training across all areas, including first aid, chainsaw training and 4x4 driving.




