SOUTHERN COUNCILS TAKING CONTROL OF WASTE

Last year, the 12 Southern Councils* established the Southern Tasmanian Regional Waste Authority (STRWA) to ensure there was a more effective and efficient coordination of waste management and resource recovery in the South.

The Board has now been appointed to drive the objectives set by the council owners which include:

1. Fostering sustainable use of resources;
2. Delivering efficient collection and reprocessing of resources;
3. Supporting opportunities for the circular economy to reduce environmental impact and grow Tasmania’s economy; and
4. Providing a collective voice for member councils on the circular economy, resource recovery and waste management and waste management in the region.

The Board comprises 2 council member representatives and 3 independent directors including:

- Dr Katrena Stephenson (Independent Chair) – former CEO of the Local Government Association of Tasmania (LGAT), former Director Environment, Development and Community at Kingborough Council.

- Corey Peterson (Independent Director) – Chief Sustainability Officer, University of Tasmania
- Ernie Hacker (Independent Director) – former Managing Director Norske Skog

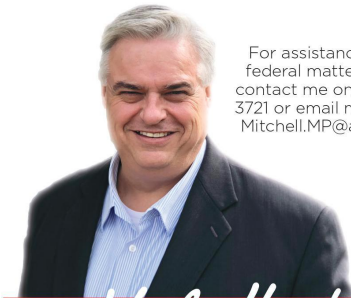

The STRWA Chair, Dr Stephenson, said “I identified opportunities for better coordination of waste and resource recovery efforts in Tasmania while CEO at LGAT and am delighted to be able to support continued improvements in this space through this new role.”

FIRES AFFECT EVERYONE!

Lucky (having, bringing or resulting from good luck) as defined in the dictionary.

We always say we were lucky but really most of the time I didn't think luck had any part in it.

Every time our fire pagers sound and we see the incident is at Dolphin Sands we take a deep breathe and well.....

On route we hope for the best, hoping for easy access and hoping the winds will abate.

Do we need more crews from our neighbouring towns, do we need to evacuate, call for air support.

Is it luck?

For us as responding emergency crews we hope that everyone will be safe and no properties are lost.

We hope that the residents impacted have done everything they can to prepare their properties, cleared vegetation appropriately around dwellings, cleared roads to allow for safe access for our responding crews, fitted their water tanks with the approved TFS fittings to allow our volunteers to easily access water to assist in protecting everyone involved.

So I suppose we don't ask much.

We ask that you all as property owners take appropriate actions to protect yourselves, your neighbours and others from the impact of fires.

Yes fires happen but what we do now can mitigate the impacts.

We can all help each other. Doing something is better than nothing at all.

The way you prepare your property is up to you, clearing the vegetation then removing it is a great option, mulching vegetation onsite is another. Fire is the less preferred option it brings many issues non more evident than escape, fires especially in the Dolphin Sands area have the potential to escape, leaf litter, travelling by the root system these are all causes of fires to escape.

Making sure that there is water readily available when conducting hazard reduction burns no matter what size, lashing or mowing there is always a chance of a spark on uneven ground.

Making sure that any pumps you may need to use are working properly and hoses are long enough to reach all area that may be affected.

Discussions are taking place and we are currently trying to organising a community information day with the relevant fire agencies.

As we get things organised we will let everyone know the details.

Hey we have been talking a lot about Dolphin sands but really fire does not discriminate it can impact us anywhere at any time.

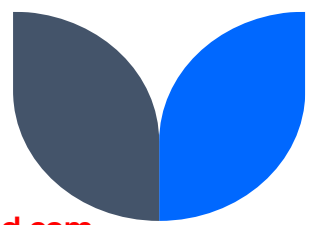
