PROPOSAL TO SHUT DOWN REGIONAL GP SERVICES

Concerns have been raised on whether Federal Tasmanian Liberals support a Liberal senator's radical proposal to shut down GP services in regional Australia.

This extraordinary proposal to rip GP

services out of regional areas would hurt people in regional Tasmania who already face significant barriers to access care.

Shutting down regional GP services will put even more pressure on Tasmania's already overwhelmed emergency departments and hospitals.

This proposal to cut regional GP services comes after the Liberals already cut the bulk-billing incentive payment to local GPs and froze GPs' pay for six years, pushing up prices for patients.

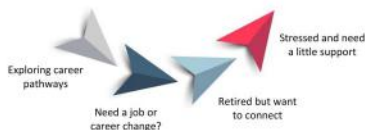

IMPORTANT NEWS FOR DOG WALKERS.



An ABC news online article (16 March 2022) explains why it's important to keep dogs on leads when you walk them on beaches.

A number of dogs have become ill or died from interactions with puffer fish washed up on beaches. Puffer fish are extremely toxic. A St Helens vet has treated several dogs who have become very ill, or died, as a result of contact with puffer fish.

Puffer fish (Family Tetraodontidae, which includes toadfishes and pufferfishes) are found around much of Australia's coastline, from the tropics around the southern coasts and including Tasmania. There are several species and most contain the lethal poison, tetrodotoxin, in the skin and internal organs.

An added benefit of keeping dogs on leads at all times when dogs are on beaches is that it's less of a threat to feeding and nesting shorebirds, many of whom are endangered.

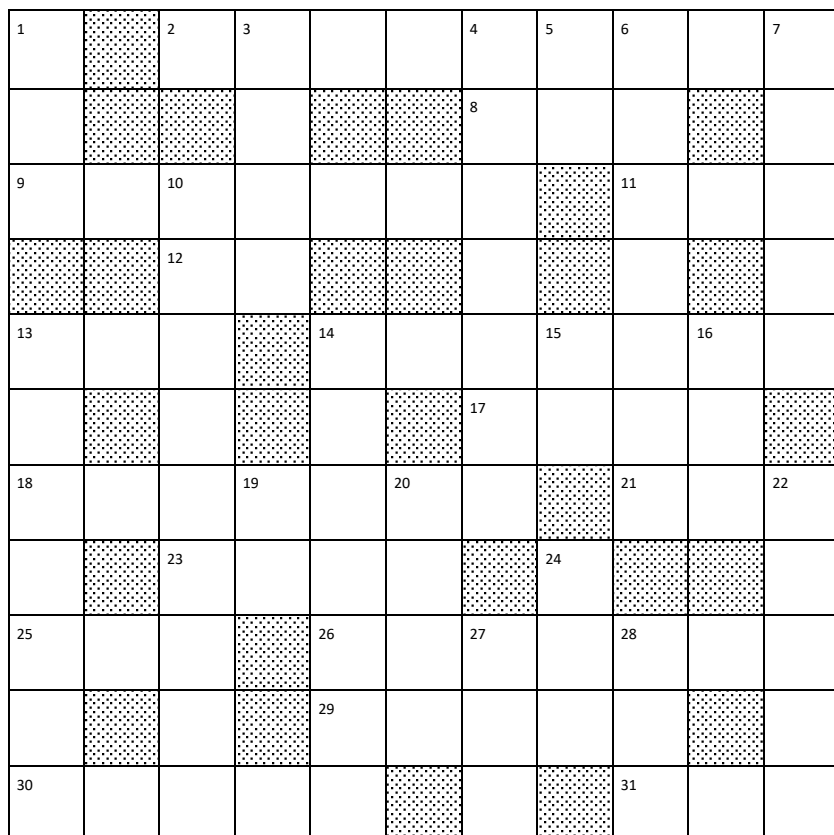
