WEST COAST WILDERNESS RAILWAY - SHUTDOWN

Today it was announced that the West Coast Wilderness Railway will shutdown to undergo major upgrade work this winter to improve the reliability and resilience of the operation.

All remaining services will close from 5 June 2023 with railway operations expected to recommence gradually in time for the peak summer tourism season.

In response to the shutdown, the Tasmanian Government has developed a \$1 million support program to drive continued visitation, while also supporting west coast operators to invest in their businesses during the winter period.

The program includes:

- a targeted travel voucher program to encourage Tasmanians to visit the west and enjoy all the attractions that are open during winter
- a small grants program for west coast businesses who wish to invest in new projects aligned to the **Small Business Growth Strategy**, as well as advice and capacity building assistance provided to the West Coast Council and West by North West regional tourism organisation to develop a heritage tourism masterplan to ensuring the railway is developed and enhanced as a visitor attraction for the long term and linked to other ventures

Further information on the support package, including the travel voucher and grant program will be available soon.

Anyone with tickets booked on affected services will be contacted directly and provided a full refund. Passengers booked on services out of Queenstown between

now and 5 June 2023 will not be affected by the shutdown.

All staff will be retained and the cafés located in Queenstown and Strahan will continue to operate.

UNDERGROUND LOVERS BOOK LAUNCH

Melding science and personal reflection, Pouliot shines a light on these whimsically strange organisms, as she explores the fungi that appear after fire, the impact of climate change on fungi and the integral role they play in our ecosystems.

Lively and astute, this book provides fascinating new insights into the lives of fungi and celebrates their astonishing

beauty and complexity. Breathtaking and evocative, *Underground Lovers* will make you see the world anew.

ALISON POULIOT is an ecologist with a passion for fungi. Her journeys in search of fungi span the northern and southern hemispheres, ensuring two autumns and a double dose of fungi each year. As a scientist, photographer, author and someone who roams the forest daily, Alison explores fungi through multiple lenses. Alison is the author of *The Allure of Fungi* and co-author of *Wild Mushrooming*.
