TASWATER LAUNCHES NEW EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES

TasWater has launched a suite of new initiatives aimed at engaging and educating school children about the water cycle, water use and sustainability, and waste management.

In a diverse approach, TasWater has launched a new microsite, a fun new game and is facilitating a performance group incursion into Tasmanian schools.

The microsite, called Sharing Water, is an interactive way for children to learn about the processes involved in getting fresh drinking water to households and what happens to waste water when it is flushed or goes down the drain.

Children can follow the journey water takes from precipitation to catchment, through treatment facilities and 6,000km of pipes to their homes. The journey concludes with returning the water to the environment.

The Sharing Water microsite will soon also feature an interactive game, called Water Wheelers, where players build water infrastructure to supply services to the community.

Finally, water-savvy character Walter

Smart and his friends will be visiting schools as part of a pilot program.

An engaging and entertaining pantomime and workshop, the Walter Smart and Friends performance group is on a mission to recruit a new generation of smart water champions.

Community Stakeholder and Customer Relations Department Manager Ruth Dowty said the new suite of educational resources underpins TasWater's commitment to improving water literacy.

"The pantomimes and workshops are aligned to the Australian curriculum and use original music and songs, comedy, and multimedia to captivate and motivate a young audience," Ms Dowty said.

"It's an engaging way to get our water use messages across to youngsters and hopefully they are inspired to take action to make changes in how they use water in their schools and homes."

"We are committed to doing our bit to educate Tasmania's young people about water as a precious resource and we believe it's important that children, and the broader public, understand where our water comes from and the processes it goes through to get to the tap," Ms Dowty said.

"The new microsite, game and school visits mean we can share these messages in a fun, engaging and interactive way."

KEEPING AREAS CLEAR FOR OUR WATER METER READERS

From snakes and bees to trees and garden beds, TasWater's meter readers face a number of hazards when they come out to take readings at properties throughout the year.

As the people on the ground customers see, TasWater is shining the light on meter readers through a new social media campaign.

TasWater Meter Reading Coordinator Heath Johnson encourages property owners to ensure their water meters are kept clear, as it can help mitigate these hazards.

"Our meter readers can come into contact with a range of different hazards each time they do a read," he said.

"Spring is when we are more commonly dealing with snakes in the meter boxes, while in autumn bees and wasps are a big nuisance.

"We encourage property owners to help us out by ensuring their water meters are kept clear, so no bushes or flowers are growing over the meters.

"This is not only to ensure we can easily access them but also results in less bees or wasps in the area."

Although water meters are installed to be read by TasWater, knowing where your meter is situated is also useful for our customers.

"We encourage our customers to find where their water meter is in on their properties, so in the event of an emergency, such as a broken pipe inside the home, you will be able to shut down the supply of water quickly and efficiently potentially averting serious damage," Mr Johnson said.

"This will also allow for customers to check their own usage and even query their bill if needed.

"We would also like to remind customers to inform us of any meter issues they might have, for example broken lids, so we can ensure they remain safe not just for our staff but for customers too."

While TasWater is working to install more water meters that can be remotely read, it will take about 15 years to renew the entire state's fleet which consists of more than 218,000 meters.

"Having clear and direct access to meters will reduce the number of estimations we are required to do when we cannot collect an actual read," Mr Johnson said.

HOW SAFE ARE GP SERVICES IN LYONS UNDER SCOTT MORRISON?

Scott Morrison and Susie Bower must immediately come clean on whether they support a [Liberal Party colleague's radical proposal to shut down GP services in regional Australia](#).

New South Wales Liberal senator Hollie Hughes made the comments during a senate committee hearing into primary health

services in regional and rural services.

"Why don't we just get rid of private practice - just fund more GPs into hospitals some way or another and just get rid of private practice?" she said.

In response, Brian Mitchell MP said: "This extraordinary proposal to rip GP services out of regional areas would have a terrible impact in Lyons, where vulnerable members of our community already face significant barriers to access healthcare."

"Why does Scott Morrison's Government think Lyons residents don't deserve access to basic healthcare?"

"Lyons rely on their local GPs but instead the Morrison Government wants patients to end up in already overwhelmed emergency departments.

"It's just more of the same from a Government that clearly doesn't care about the health of Lyons residents.

"Across Lyons, it's never been harder or more expensive to see a GP.

"Out of pocket costs to see a GP in Lyons have increased by 42% since the Liberals formed Government in 2013.

"The Morrison Government cut the bulk-billing incentive payment to local GPs and froze GPs pay for six years. This has hurt access to healthcare in Lyons.

"History shows – Scott Morrison and the Liberals will cut access to Medicare at any chance they get."

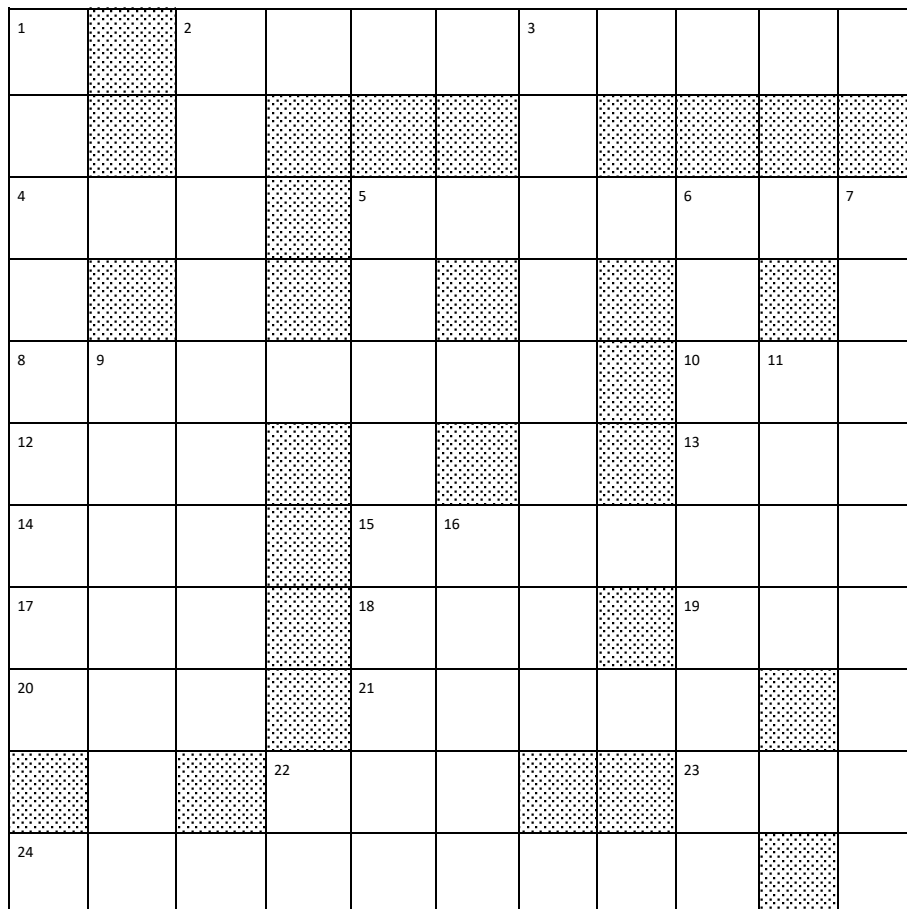
