

NEW PROJECTS TO PROTECT NATIVE SPECIES

Endangered flora and fauna are set to benefit from over \$650,000 in funding for four projects across the Lyons electorate thanks to the Morrison Government's Threatened Species Strategy Action Plan.

Liberal Senator for Tasmania, Claire Chandler said each of the four projects would target species recovery and habitat restoration.

"Four important projects spanning the Lyons electorate have been granted over \$650,000 through the Morrison Government's Environment Restoration Fund to preserve and protect native species," Senator Chandler said.

"Projects range from invasive urchin removal and monitoring efforts to complement existing strategies to restore the habitat of the critically endangered Red handfish, to improved site management of the Graveside Leek-orchid, found only in one location in the Midlands.

"These activities are community led and aim to improve the longevity of our native wildlife and natural environments." Projects to receive funding include:

- 246,000 for Improving the long-term trajectory of the endangered Swan galaxias in eastern Tasmania.
- \$90,006 to enhance the habitat for New Holland Mouse at Friendly Beaches Reserve.

Minister for the Environment Sussan Ley said conservation and restoration projects across Australia have been allocated a share of \$12 million funding through the \$100 million Environment Restoration

"The successful projects span all states and territories and will deliver practical action on the ground to protect more than 60 priority threatened species," Minister Ley said.

"This includes action to restore and create important habitat, captive breeding programs to boost populations as well as new feral cat and fox management initiatives to reduce pressures from invasive predators.

"Projects announced today will also drive forward action under the Government's recently announced Threatened Species Strategy Action Plan, which sets a pathway to coordinate practical conservation efforts for our threatened species."
