In the 'Mercury' on Tuesday 19th. April, an article inserted by Red Panda Property Group claims that the family Business of Morris' Store has been sold.

THIS IS NOT CORRECT.

The Morris Family have entered into an agreement with Red Panda Property which allows Red Panda to prepare plans and submissions to Council, The Tasmanian Heritage Council, and various Government Departments which might allow preservation work on the old building and, in the very long term, repurposing.

IF all these approvals are granted, and IF a number of other critical conditions are met, then a sale might proceed.

Amongst these conditions there is a legally binding agreement that continuing long term career employment is maintained for all our dedicated staff, and that all their status and entitlements are retained. Until all these conditions and approvals are formalised, the entire business will

continue to be owned and operated by the Morris Family.

You ask 'why might we sell'

Well, we are old and tired.

The building is old and like all old people will require on-going care which over the long term will exceed our physical and mental ability.

We could talk about the problems of operating an old fashioned business in a modern world. We could talk about the seemingly never ending increase in regulation and pointless red tape, we could talk about the discrimination against small business, particularly small family business, by all four levels of Government. We could talk about the demise of Australian manufacturing and the restrictions on stock supplies.




