TAKE A SEAT AT THE TABLE IN UPCOMING LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS

The Local Government Association of Tasmania (LGAT) and the Tasmanian Government are calling on people from all walks of life to consider running for their council in the local government elections later this year.

The joint campaign launches this week and encourages people to consider taking 'A seat at the table' to represent their local community.

LGAT President, Australian Local Government Association of Australia Vice President and West Tamar Mayor Christina Holmdahl said the campaign will encourage diversity in local government. "Strong and effective councils reflect the diverse communities they serve," Mayor Holmdahl said.

"That's why we must do all we can to encourage and empower people from a diverse range of backgrounds, abilities, genders and ages to stand for their community," she said.

Local government offers an exciting and rewarding opportunity to work with residents and businesses and make a real difference in the lives of Tasmanians.

"It's an enormous privilege to represent your community; I'd encourage everyone to consider giving it a go," she said.

Minister for Local Government Nic Street echoed the call, encouraging locals who want their voices heard to consider nominating.

"As the closest level of government to the community, councils make important decisions every day that impact peoples' lives and they should reflect the broad range of the communities they serve," Minister Street said. Councillors, Deputy Mayors and Mayors all play a vital leadership role in developing and implementing their community's vision and values.

"Over four years, they help enable the economic, social and cultural development of the community, as well as supporting individuals and groups and providing a wide range of wellbeing services.

"If you have a strong sense of community and are keen to make a difference in your local area, I urge you to consider nominating for the upcoming elections. If you are interested, there is plenty of support available to help you take that next step," he said.

Nominations for the local government elections open on 5th September, and voting starts in early October 2022.

LETTERS TO THE EDITORIAL TEAM

Another morning, another near miss. A car travelling north on Arnol Street is forced to take evasive action to avoid another vehicle reversing out of the Child Care Centre. Who or what is at fault. Speed NO. Less than 20kph, Inattention. NO. Road design and configuration and

visibility YES

After all it was never a formal road; non-existent on town plans and just evolved to grant public access to what was originally a number of private driveways.

Later in the day we see a medium size Motor Home travelling South on Arnol Street after leaving the Laundromat. Confronted head on by a small car. Situation compounded by a dog taking her providers for their daily walk. Solution: Dog leads humans to safety; Car reverses into a private driveway allowing Motor Home to pass.

That afternoon, after collecting children from Childcare, car wants to turn into Franklin Street. To do so, has to venture into the 'wrong' lane to get around a vehicle legally parked on the corner. Meets another car and trailer heading for the re-use shoppe.

Why is the no parking sign 15 metres from the corner instead of at the junction. Because it is a relic of the days when Swansea had a Government Post and Telegraph Office and the mail had to be unloaded at the side door. A need long gone. Fortunately Swansea drivers get a triple C rating. Competent, Careful and Considerate, which means that to date there has not been a major disaster.

Prevention is better than Condolences. And a simple preventive measure is to make Arnol Street 'One Way' southbound, or at least that section of Arnol Street south of the re-use shoppe.

Yes, it would cause minor inconvenience to four residents who would have to 'do the block' to get to the beach.

Submissions to Council over the past forty years have not warranted a reply. So maybe the community could implement the 'one way' strategy as voluntary code of practice.
