

MEREDITH BRIDGE BACK IN PLAY....

A revised bridge plan, a newly proposed development and renewed enthusiasm by the community has seen the Meredith River footbridge take a massive step forward in the last months.

The linkage between Swansea and Dolphin Sands paves the way for a resurgence of the Swansea Township and creates the opportunity for an array of new business opportunities, along with an exciting piece of infrastructure for the area.

The idea seemed relatively well received when re-presented to the Glamorgan Spring Bay Council on July 12th.

"Outside of the financial constraints Council currently have, the opportunity exists for a project that can bond the communities of Swansea and Dolphin Sands and enhance those areas ten-fold. Such environmentally sensitive, quality infrastructure that provides opportunities for both tourists and the local community is fabulous", Dolphin Sands Community Association secretary, Robyn Moore said.

"While many municipalities are focussing on mountain bike tracks, a flat scenic ride may be accessible to many more, including less enthusiastic bike riders".


The opportunity arrived when now locally based development company, Red Panda Property Group, took a redevelopment application for a new subdivision for north Swansea.

The 101-lot subdivision, new supermarket area and retirement village and high dependency aged care centre, comes off the back of the failed Tempus proposal, which was knocked back by the Tasmanian Planning Commission earlier this year.

"It has all sort of fallen into place in the most uncanny way. We presented the subdivision to Council, were highlighted to the previous bridge matter, and then Tempus was rejected due to its location. The planets aligned to this site on every front!", said Red Panda Director and CEO, Andrew McCullagh.

"A major sticking point ultimately will be funding, but our company will be including some aspects in our retirement village proposal, along with raising monies from the community, and looking at community grants. We will also be discussing matters with the Cambria Green proponents and how they may assist".

"The idea of the community healing some



old wounds along the way, and combining as one for such a terrific community outcome, would be the most pleasing aspect. One of our design principles is connecting what was divided, and I think that is applicable for many aspects of this proposal".

Final reports are being obtained, and they will be lodged with Council and placed out for community consultation in the months ahead.

"The reports and plans are the easy part. Our focus is now on fundraising and establishing a community initiative to facilitate this".

WITH A PLAN FOR ACTION, WE CAN END HOMELESSNESS

Homelessness Week is taking place from 1st -7th August this year, and across the country, in towns and cities, individuals and families will sleep in garages, cars, or on a mattress on the floor with their friends or family.

Everyone has the right to a safe place to call home. But skyrocketing rents put safe and stable accommodation out of reach for more and more people. Regional rents are now 18 per cent higher than they were before the COVID-19 pandemic, while rents in capital cities have increased 14.7 per cent over the past 12 months.

This is changing the face of homelessness. Many people who are in work, and have a history of secure housing, now find themselves struggling to pay rent or find affordable rentals.
