The Uniting Church has decided to sell the church which the Amos family was so instrumental in its construction.

The church's existence is the history of the Glamorgan area and the Amos family. Early diaries of the Amos family record services being held in 1840 at the granary on the property Glen Gala. Regular ser-

vices were held by Rev. Joseph Mayson (Anglican Minister) and Mr. Morrison (Congregational Missionary Minister) at the homes of Mr. Watson and Mr. Lyne on the property Glen Heriot.

In May 1844 a letter was received from Rev. James Bell, of Hobart Town, indicating that Rev. Thomas Dove could be employed under the church act if 50 signatures from east coast residents could be obtained. The Rev. Thomas Dove was appointed Presbyterian Minister for the district of Swanport on the 2nd September 1844.

Rev. Thomas Dove chaired a public meeting on the 7th October 1844, it was resolved that five acres of *Glen Gala land*, valued at £40 offered by Adam Amos be accepted.

The plan for the Kirk measured 45 feet in length, 24 feet in width and 16 feet in height, it could accommodate 200 worshippers and include a vestry and annexed schoolroom.

Alexander Reid of *Waters Meeting*
John Amos, sen. of *Cranbrook*
John Ferguson, sen.
Adam Amos, jun.
Robert Wardlaw

The treasurer James Amos travelled around the state raising funds, the Government also contributed to the Kirk.

The Lieutenant-Governor has approved of a warrant being prepared in favour of Mr. John Amos, contractor. For the building - for the sum of eighty pounds. I have the honour to be Sir, Your very obedient servant J.E. Bicheno (Colonial Secretary).

The sum raised was £464, insufficient to complete the Kirk. James Amos son of John Amos sen. offered to build the Kirk for the sum collected.

Observer Newspaper, 28th November 1845:

The new Kirk 'Glen Gala' will be publicly opened on the Sabbath the 7th December next. The Reverend J. Little is expected to officiate on the occasion.

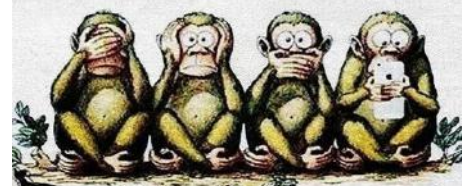
Has our own Council sold us out to private interests (yet again); and, more importantly, has it potentially handed the rights to millions of litres of our precious drinking water to foreigners?

Amos

Brothers Adam and John Amos, with their respective families, arrived in Van Diemen's Land from England in 1821, on the chartered ship *Emerald* with George Meredith and his family.

Having enough capital to select 700 acres, Adam chose his grant further north of Swansea on the Swan River; calling his property *Glen Gala*. His brother John was not in the same position and had fallen under Meredith's influence during the voyage. Meredith was able to secure a grant of 400 acres in John's name; this Meredith quickly claimed. A water-mill named 'Gala Mill' was built by convict labour on the banks of the Swan River.

Today the village of Cranbrook with its Gala Kirk and properties Glen Gala, Gala, Glen Heriot, Craigie Knowe and Cranbrook House are a testament to the Amos families.

Over the years restoration work has been undertaken to fix, the storm water system, foundation air vents, roof rafters, bracing of walls and paint work.

This building is listed under the National Trust Australia (Tas) as a significant historical early Georgian Church.

Services are no longer held in the church and the Amos family members still take care of the church today.
