SPRING BAY SQUID FESTIVAL LAUNCH

Tasmania's first Squid Festival is set to happen in trayapana / Triabunna this coming November 25-27.

Yesterday Spring Bay Mill and Artology launched the inaugural Spring Bay Squid Festival - a three-day celebration of the ocean - alongside the local Triabunna community.

"You're probably wondering what the Squid Festival is - it's part food festival, part science festival, and part performance festival... focusing on squids, of course," said Project Manager Matt Woodham.

"We're celebrating sustainability, the ocean and the long tradition of squid fishing right here in Triabunna," said Spring Bay Mill General Manager Joe Pickett.

The festival's main event will be The Squid Day Out – a community-focused, family-friendly celebration at the Spring Bay Museum & Discovery Centre. The site will be transformed with music, art installations, food stalls, roving performance, talks, workshops and the Beaker Street Science Bar.



Other Squid Festival events include the Feast in the Amphitheatre at Spring Bay Mill, a floating audio-visual installation called Squid Theory, co-presented by Big hART and a delicately curated cabaret night from the producers of cult hit The Shit Show, appropriately titled The Squid Show.

Coinciding with the festival is the Trouwana / lutruwita Ocean Summit. Presented by The Australia Institute Tasmania at Spring Bay Mill, the summit aims to engage all Tasmanians with an interest in our coastal waters to discuss and generate actions on best practice ocean management.

"Trouwana/lutruwita has some of the highest levels of marine diversity and species found nowhere else in the world, but our marine life is under pressure. The Summit will host world-leading expertise and focus on real-world examples of how
