Glamorgan Spring Bay Little Athletics Season is Finally Here!

There will be 2 registration days Thursday September 17th at 5pm and Wednesday 23rd September at 5pm Swansea football oval. We will then break for the school holidays and new registered athletes will start back at the beginning of term 4. Meets will be on a Thursday at 5pm starting on October the 15th at 5pm.

Recently we have been working hard to upgrade the long jump pit and run up track as well as line marking and getting everything ready for an exciting new and fun season.

The Glamorgan Spring Bay Little Athletics Committee would like to thank everyone who has helped out in any way. And special thanks to Morey's for the donation of gravel for the long jump pit track and Walnuts Australia for gravel and sand also to Gary Wrigley for his excavation work and to Mark Kean, Rod Pyke and Rodney Jones for their hard work. The long jump pit looks great. Also a big Thank you to Jeremy Jamson, Nikita Jamson, Paul Wright, Garrin Read, Shane Cowen, Andrew Grove and Rodney Jones for marking out the lines.

This year GSBLA has been fortunate to receive a grant from the Swansea Online Access Centre to the value of \$350 This will remove the \$2 per family fee that is in place each week, and on behalf of the committee we are very grateful for this grant.

After discussing with a lot of families, we have decided to try and get Tiny Tots up and going this year.. It runs for children from the age of 3-5 year olds, and gives them a great start into Little Athletics. We are urgently trying to get parent help for this; if you would like to help out in any way to run Tiny Tots, we would love to see you. The emphasis is on play based learning and fun. For this program to go ahead we will need parent involvement, the registration fee for Tiny Tots is \$20. (Tiny Tots don't need to be in uniform but can if they choose to be).

Registration for athletes this year is set at \$65 per person; you can go on line and register the link <http://littleathletics.com.au/> click Register Here and then select Glamorgan Spring Bay Little Athletics. All children from Under 6 (aged 5 years as of October 1st 2015) to under 15 are welcome to attend and participate in this fun and active environment, with Tiny Tots for 3 to 5 years we have all children covered this year. Centre uniform is navy t-shirt and black shorts.

We are looking forward to a busy season with lots of old and new athletes. Come along have some fun, see you there!



Arts in our Community

ECCAI is the group that has taken on the responsibility for supporting all Arts activity in our community. With the ECCAI AGM planned for 4pm on 23 September in the All Saints Church Hall, I thought I'd take the opportunity of explaining (or reminding) what we are and how we support the Arts.

1. What is ECCAI?

East Coast Community Arts Initiative

East Coast - We plan to represent arts groups in the GSB Municipality - Orford to Bicheno.

Community Arts - We will coordinate any events proposed from within the community or offered by external arts bodies to bring to our locality.

Initiative - We actively seek events and activities. We don't just wait for proposals to come to us.

We were formerly known as the Great Oyster Bay Regional Arts Group and were affiliated with Tasmanian Regional Arts.

With recent government funding cuts we found our subscription to Tasmanian Regional Arts were far greater than the benefits provided. Last year we decided to go it alone and I hope you agree that there has been no decline in the arts activity in our community as a result.

2. What do we do?

ECCAI uses its contacts and network to encourage artists and performers to bring their creations to our community.

We are the first point of contact for anyone within our community wishing to promote or sponsor an event. This can be from the "bright idea" stage to a fully planned event.

We will coordinate with venue providers to ensure suitable staging of events.

We undertake advertising and promotion of events.

Underwrite shows to guarantee they will come to us.

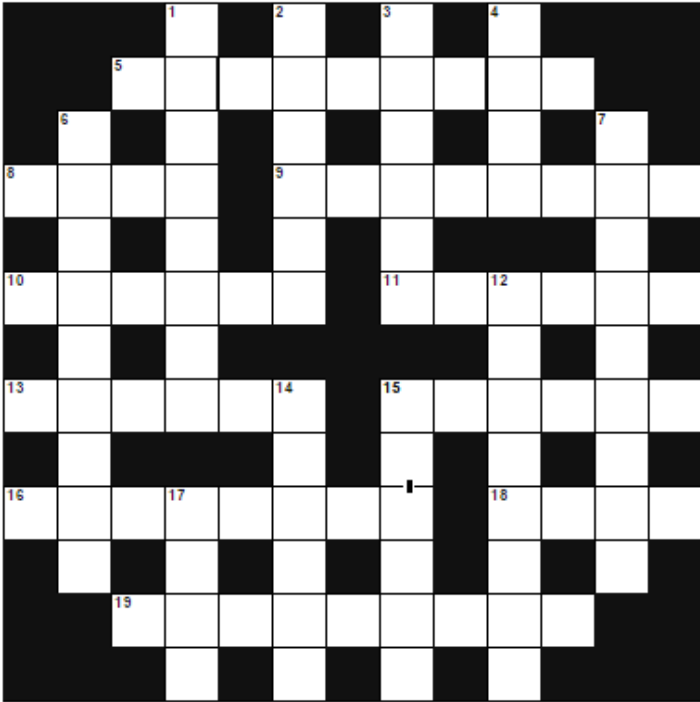
