Sarah has been on Tourism Tasmania's board since September 2021 and when she commences in the position will transition from a non-executive director to the CEO's role as executive director on the board.

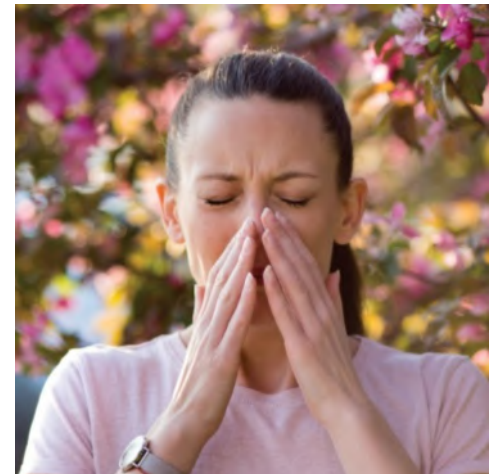
Sarah will officially commence as Tourism Tasmania's chief executive officer in early 2023.
