LOCAL RESIDENTS WHO USE THE OLD **COACH ROAD**

There has been a significant landslip on Old Coach Road and the road was closed on the weekend for safety reasons. (See attached photos). Emergency services have been notified and information has been posted on Councils website and FB page.

A traffic counter was installed on Old Coach Road recently, over the quieter period, which indicated an average of approx. 36 cars per day. We are mindful that the traffic volume increases on this road over the holiday/Xmas season. Some of these vehicles would be going to local farms and the rest would be going through to Royal George and onwards to Avoca. We have advised the works manager at the Northern Midlands council



and they are putting it up on the web site and face book site.

Staff inspected the site on Saturday and another 70 metre long portion of the road has severe cracking and may also collapse. The recent inclement weather is likely the cause of the slip. The road is sign posted to alert drivers to the road closure and hazard.

Please be aware that reinstatement of the road is not a quick fix but we will be doing our best to design and carry out re instatement as soon as practical. At this stage we cannot provide a timeframe for the road closure. We don't need more rain!

As the Tasmanian fire season approaches, it's important to have a plan and know your options. Community Bushfire Protection Planning is a national initiative that helps to identify safety options during a bushfire threat.

Tasmania Fire Service works closely with communities, local government, service providers, and other government agencies to create Community Bushfire Protection Plans and implement risk management strategies.

Each plan is tailored to individual communities to best suit their needs.

Tasmania Fire Service Chief Officer, Dermot Barry said it was important for people to be prepared, regardless of whether they choose to stay or leave if a bushfire threatens their community.

"Understanding risks and taking steps to mitigate them is important for everyone, but especially those living in bushfire prone areas," he said.

"We want to make sure people are informed, prepared and ready for when a bushfire strikes."

Community Bushfire Protection Plans provide advice on what to do:

- Before the fire
- When fires are likely or nearby; &
- After the fire.

There are currently 139 Community Bushfire Protection Plans in place across Tasmania, with nine new plans for Murdunna, Heybridge, Redpa, Marrawah, Ringarooma, Bakers Beach, Penguin, Beechford and Deviot due to be added soon. Additionally, 11 existing plans have been updated in Strahan, Zeehan, Molesworth, Tinderbox, Campania, Eagle Hawk Neck, Ansons Bay, Claude Road, Taranna, Cradle Mountain and South Hobart.




