# SWANSEA GENERAL PRACTICE

Due to recent changes to Medicare please find below our policy on the renewal of prescriptions and to telehealth consultations.

#### **PRESCRIPTIONS:**

- If you have been seen by a GP at our Practice within the past 3 months, you can request a prescription renewal for a fee of \$10.
- If you have not been seen by a GP at our Practice within the past 3 months, you will need to book an appointment.

#### **TELEHEALTH CONSULTATIONS:**

• If you would like to book a telehealth phone appointment there is now a private fee of \$25, this must be paid at the time of booking your appointment, this can be made over the phone using your Credit or Debit card and is not claimable through Medicare. Telehealth is only available if you have seen a GP face to face at our practice within the past 12 months.

#### **COVID INJECTIONS:**

Our next Covid vaccination supply should arrive by the 20th of November.

- All adults 18 years or older should have a COVID booster in 2023. This should occur if it's been 6 months or longer since the last COVID booster or confirmed infection (whichever is most recent). Boosters give extra protection against severe illness from COVID.
- All adults aged 65 years and older should receive an extra 2023 COVID-19 vaccine dose if six months has passed since the last dose. A second 2023 booster dose is NOT recommended in people under 65 years.
- 2023 booster doses are not recommended at this time for children and adolescents under 18 years of age who do not have any risk factors for severe COVID-19.

#### SHINGLES VACCINATIONS:

Free shingles vaccination under the National Immunisation Program (NIP) is

available for eligible people most at risk of complications from shingles.

A 2-dose course of Shingrix is available for free for:

- people aged 65 years and over
- First Nations people aged 50 years and over
- immunocompromised people aged 18 years and over with the following medical conditions:
- ⇒ haematopoietic stem cell transplant
- ⇒ solid organ transplant
- ⇒ haematological malignancy
- ⇒ advanced or untreated HIV.

If you previously received a free Zostavax shingles vaccine under the NIP, you are not eligible for a free Shingrix vaccine for at least 5 years after your Zostavax was administered.

If you purchased the Zostavax vaccine privately, you can receive Shingrix for free under the program if you're eligible. You should wait at least 12 months between receiving Zostavax and getting the Shingrix vaccine.

We are expecting Shingrix stock to arrive after the 20th November. Please call the Practice on 62578205 to make an appointment.

If you have any further questions about vaccines, please talk to your GP.

# INTEGRITY COMMISSION RESPONDS TO MATTERS RAISED IN PARLIAMENT

The Integrity Commission notes the statements made in Parliament yesterday about the outcomes of the Commission of Inquiry into the Tasmanian Government's Responses to Child Sexual Abuse in Institutional Settings.

Chief Commissioner Greg Melick said: "The conclusions mentioned in Parliament were wrong in law and, insofar as they relate to the Integrity Commission and its Officers, they are incorrect.

"I can advise the following facts:

- The Integrity Commission was provided several draft chapters by the Commission of Inquiry for review.
- We understood that the draft chapters had been written by Commission of Inquiry staff and had not at that stage been reviewed by the Commissioners themselves.
- As requested, we provided responses that focussed on correcting factual matters or misunderstandings of our submissions and/or evidence. We did not characterise this as 'procedural fairness'.
- There were no proposed 'adverse findings' or findings of misconduct about the Integrity Commission's CEO, Michael Easton, or any other past or present employees or Officers of the Commission.
- The draft chapters were not provided under a notice of 'potential adverse finding' (s.18 or s.19 notice) and no such notices have been received by the Integrity Commission.

At no stage did the Integrity Commission seek or receive assistance from any government or other lawyers on any issues relating to findings, or seek to amend the findings.

"The Integrity Commission seeks to act transparently at all times, and in the best interests of children and the public.

"We have accepted the findings made by the Commission of Inquiry, and have commenced implementation of its recommendations."



## **NEW TOILETS FOR FREYCINET** NATIONAL PARK TO HELP VISITOR **EXPERIENCE**

The Rockliff Liberal Government is building the infrastructure we need in our national parks and reserves to turbocharge the Tasmanian economy and create jobs in regional Tasmania.

Minister for Parks, Nick Duigan, said work has started on construction of new toilets at the Freycinet National Park Peninsula Circuit to help improve the visitor experience.

"Tasmanian Parks and Wildlife Service has awarded a contract to East Coast Constructions to replace the toilets at South Wineglass Bay and Cooks Beach Campgrounds," Minister Duigan said.

"The \$550,000 works, funded by the Government's Boost Maintenance Funding, are expected to take about three months to complete.

"Walker access to existing amenities during construction will not be affected, and works will aim to keep impacts on the walker experience to a minimum.

"Due to the remote location of the toilets, a helicopter will be required to

transport all materials to site, which may result in some low-level construction noise during daylight hours.

"The new toilets will provide a modern remote toilet system, similar in design to the North Wineglass Bay Toilet, benefitting walkers visiting the area and ensuring the local environment is protected.

"In addition to Freycinet's new toilets, the Boost Maintenance Funding program is contributing significantly to other priority infrastructure projects, including \$20,000 worth of repair works to Claytons Jetty in the Southwest National Park, to keep the structure operational, and \$260,000 towards repairs and removal of asbestos to keep volunteers and PWS staff safe on Maatsuyker Island.

"The Highfield Historic Site received \$220,000 for important heritage building protection, and the Jaffa Vale Track in the Walls of Jerusalem National Park received \$50,000 to complete the final stage of track repairs."

The Rockliff Liberal Government will continue to deliver our long-term plan to do what matters for all Tasmanians and keep the economy strong.




