



Illegal vegetation clearing update – Swansea.

Revegetation at the site of illegal vegetation clearing in Swansea has begun. The native species that were illegally destroyed were a mixture of Drooping Sheoak (Allocasuarina verticillata), Sticky Hop-Bush (Dodonaea viscosa), Prickly Box (Bursaria spinosa) and Black Wattle (Acacia mearnsii).

Thirty natives consisting of a mixture of the species listed above have been planted at the site as part of revegetation efforts. The site will be monitored by both Glamorgan Spring Bay Council and Tasmania Police.


