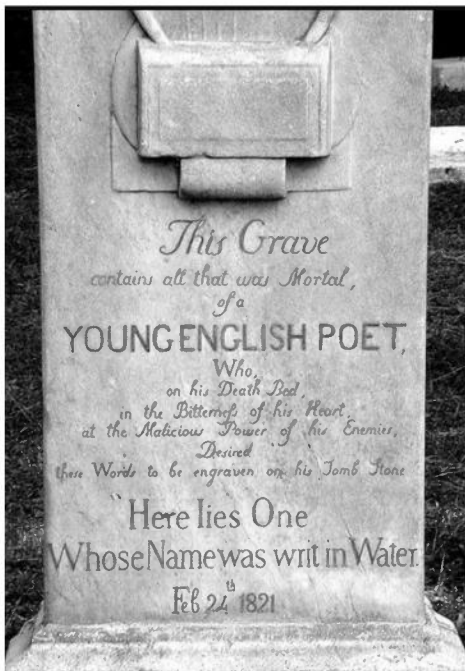

## Illegal destruction of vegetation on Cambria Drive walking track.

Glamorgan Spring Bay Council has investigated further instances of illegal destruction of native vegetation along one of the walking tracks from Cambria Drive to Nine Mile Beach.

Signage has been erected at the site and correspondence has been posted ratepayers in the vicinity of this location.

It is illegal to clear, poison or otherwise destroy or interfere with vegetation on public land. The Cambria Drive walking track will be monitored by both Glamorgan Spring Bay Council and Tasmania Police.

### Illegal vegetation clearing update – Swansea.

Revegetation at the site of illegal vegetation clearing in Swansea has begun. The native species that were illegally destroyed were a mixture of Drooping Sheoak (*Allocasuarina verticillata*), Sticky Hop-Bush (*Dodonaea viscosa*), Prickly Box (*Bursaria spinosa*) and Black Wattle (*Acacia mearnsii*).

Thirty natives consisting of a mixture of the species listed above have been planted at the site as part of revegetation efforts. The site will be monitored by both Glamorgan Spring Bay Council and Tasmania Police.
