Know your Bushfire Risk
Below is the Advice Levels for Bushfires
Provided by the Tasmania Fire Service

### Advice -

A bushfire has started and general information is provided to keep individuals, households and communities up-to-date with developments.

### Watch and Act -

A bushfire is approaching and conditions are changing. Individuals, households and communities need to monitor their development and start taking action to ensure safety should the threat escalate.

### **Emergency Warnings -**

Individuals, households and communities will be impacted and are in imminent danger. Action must be taken immediately.

Are you Bushfire ready?
Have you got a current bushfire survival plan?
Have you practiced your plan?
Are you going to "Stay and Defend" or "Leave Early"?
Are you prepared and resourced to actively defend your property?

Did you know this information is easily accessibly on the Tasmania Fire Service website www.fire.tas.gov.au or by contacting them on 1800 000 699 or by contacting your local fire brigade.

The heading on the TASMANIA FIRE SERVICE website "Community Bushfire Planning" provides information on

- Community Protection Plans
- Evacuation Centres
- Nearby Safer Places

Information is provided on all towns in our Municipal Area.

In particular the "Near By Safer Places" for Swansea are listed as the Swansea Recreation Ground and the Swansea Primary School. These will depend on the fire, or situation, at the time and will be advised on the Tasmania Fire Service Website, ABC (and other) radio stations, at community information sessions (these may be held during fires etc to advise the community of possible threats and other vital information) and via personal contact with various authorities during the situation.

Evacuation centres may not be used at every incident and will be organised by council and requested by response management authorities. We occasionally use spontaneous volunteers during emergencies; this is at the discretion of the emergency services & council and is on a needs basis.

The organising of emergency accommodation etc. is generally under the control of the relevant support agencies. We live in a world of technology unfortunately if it stops working we are at a loss. The best way to stay up to date during a bushfire or other situation is to use multiple information sources (ABC radio is the major broadcaster of emergency information, but most other radio stations now broadcast emergency information on a regular basis during such incidents). Don't just rely on the radio, check websites on your mobile device, Facebook and Twitter; keep an eye on the situation for yourself (from a safe distance) and be prepared to leave if conditions change. Keep in touch with your neighbours and other community members as they may know something that you don't.




