

They're close enough to provide support for their father.

Bertrand has told me it's all right to post this notice, to let his Tassie friends know what is happening to him. The condition he has is Myelodysplastic Syndrome, which sadly, has progressed to Acute Leukaemia. His symptoms of chronic fatigue and weakness take their toll, of course. A month ago he began a course of chemotherapy, which adds to his distress and he requires regular blood transfusions to combat the effects of chemo. He'll have to endure five more months of treatment, before his haematologist can give him a definitive prognosis.

Despite these difficulties, he's doing his best to lead a normal life, managing his household (with some assistance) and spending time with family, while playing the occasional game of petanque with his cobbers. He relishes happy memories of his time here, but misses the relaxing lifestyle of Tassie's east coast. He'd have thoroughly enjoyed this weekend, socialising with tourists and his mates at Bicheno's Food and Wine Festival.

He sends everyone his very best wishes!




