SWANSEA UPDATED

We will be clearing logs under the Meredith River Bridge on the Tasman Highway in Swansea until Wednesday, 14 December 2022.

There will be a reduced speed limit and frequent lane closures during our working hours, 7:00 am - 5:00 pm.

ELEPHANT PASS ROAD. GRAY

ONE LANE HAS BEEN CLOSED on a short section of Elephant Pass. The road remains open and temporary traffic signals are in place to guide you through the 150-metre lane closure. We are continuing to monitor the length of Elephant Pass Road and will let you know if there is any change to current road conditions. Please drive with caution and look out for the lane closure.
