#### Living Lighter is the Key to Preventing Poor Health

Heart Foundation CEO Graeme Lynch on how making small changes to our lifestyle can make a big difference. More than two-thirds of Tasmanians are overweight or obese, according to the Australian Bureau of Statistics. In this we top the national charts – all the other states and territories, while still not great, fare better than we do when it comes to maintaining a healthy weight.

Of Tasmanian men aged between 45 and 54, more than 86 per cent are in that unhealthy weight range. These are numbers that would have been shocking to previous generations.

It's troubling that being overweight seems to be fast becoming the new normal. A recent LiveLighter survey finding that intrigued me, was that of the people who are overweight or obese, one in three believe that they're not overweight at all, but are in fact within the healthy range. Sadly, this is understandable; when the majority of the people around are not maintaining a healthy weight it's reasonable to assume that you are within the normal limit. If you don't maintain a healthy weight, your chance of developing heart disease, type 2 diabetes, several types of cancer, and fatty liver disease increase. These are conditions that take a huge toll on our quality of life, lead to premature death, and cost the state's health system many millions of dollars each year. They also fall well and truly into the "preventable" category.

By now you will probably have seen our LiveLighter campaign in the media. The ads feature footage taken with an endoscope inside the abdominal cavity of a moderately overweight person. It shows what we've come to recognise as "toxic fat" built up around the internal organs. Whereas we used to think that fat around the belly was just an energy store, we now know that it can release harmful chemicals and hormones that hasten the onset of disease. If you can grab your gut, you are probably carrying toxic fat. This is the driving premise behind LiveLighter: lose the gut.

First, it's a matter of acknowledging that a change needs to be made. For some that need is quite apparent, but for those of us who haven't really thought about it there are some simple questions you can quickly find the answer to. What's my body mass index, and what should it be? While not the be all and end all of diagnoses, BMI is a useful measure that can help you work out where you are on the weight spectrum. The LiveLighter website has a calculator you can use to work out your own BMI.

What's a healthy waist measurement? For men, a reading of more than 94 centimetres is a clue that you're at risk of ill health. For women it's 80 centimetres. Of course, in some situations these measurements will not give an entirely accurate assessment. If you're a pregnant woman or a front-row rugby player you won't fit the test so well. But knowing your BMI and waist size is a good start.

If you do find yourself in the unhealthy range, it's time to begin making some changes. Walk a bit more. Take the kids to the playground more frequently. Plan your meals more thoughtfully. Don't upsize your (occasional) takeaway. Break bad habits and create healthy ones.




The LiveLighter website will give you some ideas on how to live healthier that really work. It tells us:

- CALCULATE your risk through BMI or waist measurement.
- CHALLENGE yourself, set goals, and be accountable.
- PLAN to eat well. It doesn't happen by accident. LiveLighter's meal planners can help.
- MOVE at least 30 minutes a day something that gets your pulse rate up. Cycling or fast walking is ideal.
- COMMIT to healthier habits and choose changes that you can maintain for life, and that you can pass on to your kids.

If you're concerned about your weight, a trip to your GP is also highly advisable. Everyone is different, after all, and some tailored advice can go a long way.

The preventative healthcare debate isn't going away any time soon. We will come to realise that the bang for buck you get out of prevention is far higher than dealing with the fallout. We should be emulating countries like New Zealand and Canada, whose expenditure on preventative healthcare is up to 6 per cent of the health budget. In Tasmania, it's less than 2 per cent.






