



#### NEW WEBSITE A USEFUL TOOL IN COMBATTING BIKE THEFT

Bicycle Network has welcomed the new Tasmanian Police and Crimestoppers Bikelinc website as another tool to help Tasmanian bike owners combat theft.

"Finding your bike has been stolen is gutwrenching, especially if you rely on it to get around," Bicycle Network spokesperson Alison Hetherington said.

"Bikes aren't just another possession, for many riders their bike is a source of joy: it's what provides their fun on the weekend or is their main means of transport.

"Many owners put time and money into customising their bikes, so it's not as easy as just replacing it if it gets stolen.

"And now more people are relying on e-bikes to get around, replacing a stolen bike can be an expensive exercise.

"Being able to register your bike on Bikelinc and report it as stolen straight away could increase the likelihood of it being recovered.

"It will also be a useful check for people wanting to buy a second-hand bike to make sure they are buying it from the legitimate owner.

"While bike theft may be seen as a low-value crime, it means a lot to bike owners to know police are taking their loss seriously.

"It's heartening to see Tasmania Police and Crime Stoppers putting in that extra effort to try and reunite people with their bikes.

"More than half of the Tasmanian households surveyed in the 2021 national cycling survey said they owned one or more bicycles, which if extrapolated could mean hundreds of thousands of bikes.

"It's important bike owners understand the risk of theft by using a lock that is difficult to cut, ensuring garages are secure, and recording

their bike's details in case it's stolen," Ms Hetherington said.

# WORKFORCE SURVEY HIGHLIGHTS MAJOR JOBS AND SKILLS CHALLENGE

Australia's 537 councils are looking to work with the Commonwealth Government to deliver Australia more engineers, town planners, building surveyors, environmental health officers, accountants and HR professionals, according to a new snapshot of the nation's local government workforce released today.

ALGA President Cr Linda Scott said the 2022 Local Government Workforce Skills and Capability Survey highlighted the magnitude of the current jobs and skills crisis.

"More than nine out of every 10 councils are currently facing jobs and skills shortages which are acting as a handbrake on local productivity," said Cr Scott.

"When councils can't get the staff we need to build much-needed libraries and pools, or maintain our roads, footpaths and cycleways, the impacts are felt right across our nation."

The 2022 Local Government Workforce Skills and Capability Survey was funded by the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, Communications and the Arts, and updates a previous survey in 2018.

Cr Scott said the 2022 survey results shAowed the jobs and skills crisis in local government is deepening.

"In just four years, we've seen the number of councils experiencing jobs and skills shortages increase by around 30 percent," Cr Scott said.

"The main issues councils are experiencing are a shortage of skilled candidates, and often an inability to compete with the private sector and other levels of government on remuneration."

Cr Scott said local governments could play a bigger role addressing Australia's broader jobs and skills crisis, including through giving young people a start through traineeships and apprenticeships.

"It was fantastic to see the announcement of an extra \$1 billion for fee-free TAFE places at the recent Jobs and Skills Summit but we're seeking funding that will support councils to employ more apprentices and create jobs and new career pathways right across our nation," Cr Scott said.

"As the level of government closest to its community, local governments are ideally placed to be an anchor organisation in the community, supporting economic development and local employment.

"But for councils to play a bigger role in addressing the shortages, we need more funding and support from all levels of government.

"Federal Financial Assistance Grants to councils have slipped from one percent of Commonwealth taxation revenue in 1996 to just 0.52 percent today, and this is making it harder for councils to attract and retain the staff they need.

"With a full picture of the jobs and skills gaps across our sector, we look forward to working with all levels of government towards practical solutions."



## NEW FIRE DANGER RATINGS HELP PEOPLE PREPARE FOR BUSH-FIRE

A new and nationally consistent fire danger rating system was launched across Australia on 1 September 2022. It has been implemented in Tasmania by the Tasmania Fire Service. The system provides clearer and more accurate information to people at risk of bushfire.

The new Australian Fire Danger Rating System (AFDRS) brings together the latest science and knowledge of fire behaviour. Supported by extensive community research, AFDRS is the most significant change to the fire danger ratings system in more than 50 years.

Under the previous system, fire danger ratings were based largely on forest and grass fire models. The new system uses eight different types of vegetation, which have been mapped across Australia. Based on fuel types, a further 22 sub-categories support the system, meaning we can look forward to more accurate predictions.

#### WHAT YOU'LL NEED TO KNOW

The new Australian Fire Danger Rating System forecasts the potential level of risk - before a bushfire starts.

Ratings are calculated using weather forecast and vegetation information.

The display of daily ratings has been simplified. Four levels of fire danger rating will be used, with clear actions for people to take at each level.

- Moderate (Green) Plan and prepare
- High (Yellow) Be ready to act
- Extreme (Orange) Take action now to protect life and property
- Catastrophic (Red) For your survival, leave bush fire risk areas

No rating (White section under Moderate) - means if a fire does start, it is not likely to threaten the safety of the community.

You will find daily fire danger ratings on both the Tasmania Fire Service (www.fire.tas.gov.au) and Bureau of Meteorology (www.bom.gov.au) websites. As in the past, the daily fire danger rating tables will show forecast fire danger based on fire weather areas. The maps provided by the TFS will show a finer scale and so give more local detail.

Fire Permits and Total Fire Ban declarations will be made by the Tasmania Fire Service in the usual way.







# ROAD & WEATHER REPORT

# Roadworks Report Friday, 25<sup>th</sup> Nov. -Friday, 09<sup>nd</sup> Dec. 2022

#### ORFORD NEW

We will be doing maintenance on the rockface at Paradise Gorge on the Tasman Highway from Wednesday, 7 December until Thursday, 8 December 2022.

There will be a reduced speed limit with frequent lane closures during our working hours, 7:00 am - 5:00 pm.

#### **SWANSEA**

We will be clearing logs under the Meredith River Bridge on the Tasman Highway in Swansea until Wednesday, 14 December 2022. There will be a reduced speed limit and frequent lane closures during our working hours, 7:00 am - 5:00 pm.

#### ELEPHANT PASS ROAD GRAY UPDATED

Elephant Pass remains open to all road users with a reduced speed limit and a short section that has been **reduced to one lane**. Elephant Pass is our recommended detour during the closure of St Marys Pass.

Work on longer term repairs started this week. The repairs include a retaining wall to shore up the cracked section of the road, and repairs to the road surface to keep it in a safe and driveable condition.

We are actively monitoring the road to identify any change in its condition. This monitoring shows that the road is safe for use with the measures we have put in place

#### ST MARYS PASS ST MARYS

St Marys Pass remains **closed to all traffic** following a landslip and undermining of the road last week.

Construction is underway, with our contractor making good progress on the extensive excavation works required.

It is estimated to be several weeks before the road will be safe to open.

Elephant Pass is open as a **detour** but is currently reduced to one lane for a 150-metre section under a reduced speed limit.

#### TASMAN HIGHWAY ACTON - HOBART AIRPORT

Constructing a new Hobart Airport Interchange between the Acton Interchange and Hobart Airport roundabout until late 2022. Reduced speed limit with frequent lane closures between 7:00 am - 6.00 pm.
