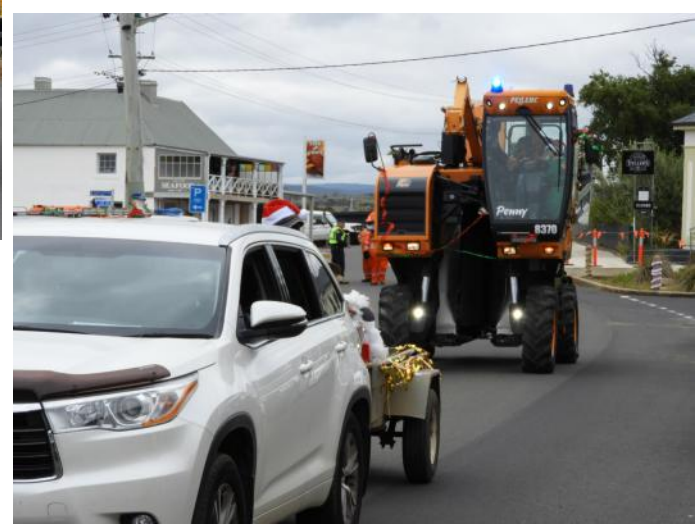

FRIDAY, 16TH - 30TH DEC. 2022

### COLES BAY UPDATED

We will be repairing the Tasman Highway between Coles Bay Road and Barbers Creek Bridge, Bicheno until Saturday, 24 December 2022.

There will be a reduced speed limit with frequent lane closures during our working hours, 9:00 am - 3:00 pm.

### CRANBROOK - MYRTLE BANK UPDATED

We will be repairing the Tasman Highway between Glen Gala Road, Cranbrook and Myrtle Bank Road, Myrtle Bank, until Tuesday, 31 January 2023.

There will be a reduced speed limit and frequent lane closures during our working hours, 7:30 am - 5:30 pm.

### ELEPHANT PASS ROAD GRAY UPDATED

Elephant Pass remains open to all road users with a reduced speed limit and a short section that has been **reduced to one lane**. Elephant Pass is our recommended detour during the closure of St Marys Pass.

St Marys Pass remains on track to open

Monday, 19 December 2022, weather permitting.

Elephant Pass will remain open over the Christmas break and will continue to be inspected twice a day.
