

The Tasmania Fire Service can declare a Total Fire Ban on days when the danger of fire is extremely high and when fires would be expected to develop rapidly and to be extremely difficult to control. Usually a Total Fire Ban lasts for 24 hours.

Days of Total Fire Ban are advertised in daily newspapers, on television and radio and on the TFS website

On Days of Total Fire Ban, all outdoor fires are banned except electric stoves and barbecues, and gas stoves and barbecues provided they are cleared of flammable material for at least one metre. All barbeques, portable stoves, pizza ovens etc that use wood, charcoal, heat beads or other solid or liquid fuel are banned.

Bush walkers are advised that the only cooking appliance that can be used on Total Fire Ban Days are LPG (Butane or Propane) cookers or stoves providing that they are clear of any flammable material for a distance of 1 metre.

Work practices such as grinding, welding and cutting metal in the open are not permitted. The use of Machinery Operations Guideline may be subject to restrictions or prohibited on the declaration of a total fire ban. All fire permits are automatically suspended.

#### New Year brings payments boost for **Young People, Carers and Students**

Young people, carers and students received a boost on 1 January 2023 with the indexation of their social security payments.

Youth Allowance increased between \$19.10 and \$41.40 a fortnight. The 6.1 per cent increase was the largest in the Youth Allowance's 25-year history.

Austudy went up between \$32.40 and \$41.40 a fortnight, depending on living arrangements and dependent children. People under 21 without children receiving Disability Support Pension will receive payment increases of between \$27.40 and \$40.70 a fortnight, including Youth Disability Supplement.

Rates of ABSTUDY and Assistance for Isolated Children will increase, as will Mobility Allowance, Double Orphan Pension, Carer Allowance and Pharmaceutical Allowance.

Brian Mitchell, Federal Member for Lyons, said:

"With the cost of living going up, these higher-than-usual indexation increases will make a difference, enabling young people and carers to afford a few more groceries or put money towards higher rents"

Other payments and thresholds, such as adult pensions, JobSeeker Payment and Parenting Payment are indexed at other times of the year.


