WE NEED YOU!

We live in an amazing part of the world surrounded by beauty, historic towns, coastal views and great communities throughout.

Our communities would not be what they are without our volunteers, whether they be helping at the local school, the sporting clubs they are all vital in the everyday running of their respective organisations.

We often forget that our local emergency services are volunteers, they are a highly trained, dedicated and committed group of community minded individuals that come

together to protect and support their respective community.

We always think that in an emergency we dial triple zero, someone hundreds of kilometres away answers the phone and dispatches the appropriate help to assist as quick as possible.

Yep tick all those boxes. But what do we expect as quick as possible to be. In the city we expect emergency services with in 10 min or less, hey they are paid on station and ready to respond.

The difference stops there outside of the city areas our emergency services are volunteers with other jobs, family, and not waiting at the station for callouts.

So the time frame looks something like this , incident is called into operators in Hobart information is collated and relayed

via pager to the appropriate service, volunteers receive the pager call stop what they are doing (change their plans, shut up shop or what ever is needed) and respond to their respective building.

Get their protective clothing on and respond.

This could take up to 10 minutes or more just to get to heading out of the building (depending on how far they live away).

Then add the time to get to the incident from the building.

This is also dependent on our volunteers being available. So what does this all mean? Yes you will get help!

As soon as possible!

The responding volunteers may only be few in numbers or from neighbouring towns. How can you help!

Remember that many hands make light work and may even help to reduce call out time so assistance can arrive sooner.

The commitment of a volunteer isn't onerous, it really is what you are able to put in, most of our training is held on a fortnightly basis usually around 2.5 hours.

Dial Triple Zero is the only way to get that Help as quick as possible, don't ring one of our volunteers direct it only slows the process down.

Whether you like boats, big red trucks, cars, want to help people when they are at their worst.

Then why not consider joining one of our amazing volunteer emergency services Swansea Fire Brigade, Swansea Ambulance Group, Glamorgan Spring Bay SES or Freycinet VMR or your local communities service where you are.

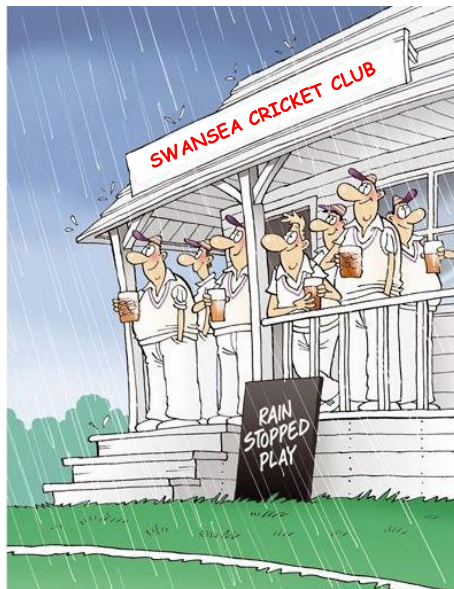
