



A LETTER FROM THE COORDINATOR SWANSEA ONLINE ACCESS CENTRE (SOAC)

SOAC is funded by the Tasmanian Government through Libraries Tasmania (LT) and for the last 22 years have produced the Great Oyster Bay Community Newsletter (GOBC).

The Grant Deed between LT & SOAC stipulates the expenditure that the grant funds can be expended upon. This entails SOAC having to provide LT with an annual audit report and financials that specifically shows that the funds have been accounted for in that particular year. The Grant Deed stipulates that no other expenditure is permitted out of the deed funds.

SOAC is an incorporated entity under the Tasmanian Corporate Affairs regime and is managed by a Committee of Management, and must submit an annual report to the Tas. Dept of Justice. All Income & Expenditure, including GOBC, has to be reported.

Over the last few weeks, Rob Gaspari, our desktop publisher, has placed notices in GOBC requesting that when our readers pick up a hardcopy that they only take one copy. The reason for this request is, despite printing 600 copies an issue, the newsletter is unavailable shortly after being delivered to our distribution points.

Yesterday Thursday 23rd March, a lady came into our offices, and made a request, that especially between Christmas and Easter, we print more copies for distribution. She stated that she collects multiple copies from the outlets for other people.

GOBC will not be printing more copies for among other reasons, the cost of paper has doubled in price since the beginning of December 2022, and is becoming harder to source because of the closure of the Maryvale Mill in Victoria.

The newsletter is a free of charge publication printed thanks to the many advertisers, who pay for their ads ensuring that the newsletter remains FOC.

Whilst we acknowledge that not all people have internet access, the very reason for SOAC's existence, the newsletter is available on our website

www.gobcnews.weebly.com and can be sent to our subscribers by email each week.

Please help us to keep you informed by only taking one copy. Pass it on after you have read it and it will able to be read by all.

Other alternative are that we would have to place a charge on the newsletter which would lead to more hassles for our distributors, or to stop the production of GOBC completely.






