



LOCAL GROUP ASSISTING LAND-CARE IN CLEAN UP

If you're driving around Dolphin Sands of a weekend morning, you might chance to see a few people in hi-viz vests digging along the roadside. Despite appearances, they aren't offenders doing mandatory community service sentences. Rather, we are just local residents, with the Dolphin Sands Community Association (DSCA) doing some Landcare activity. This is mostly removal of invasive weeds like Thistles (Scotch and Californian varieties), Dyer's Rocket, Mullein and others - especially before they disperse seeds and multiply. We put out safety signs where we're working and thanks to all those driving by who slow down for us. Lots of people wave, which is always welcome. Even better would be offers of pitching in for an

hour or so, whether or not it was just a one-off. We had a mainland tourist who was passing by join the team for an hour one day, so that was rather special we thought. We're a pretty friendly bunch who don't take ourselves too seriously, so it's always an enjoyable time that we have — weather permitting of course.

We just weed the roadside verges without encroaching on private property, but of course the weeds don't observe such proprieties. If you do find them on yours or along your boundaries, some preventative action on your parta will pay rich dividends and save everyone a lot of work in the long run. One of the more difficult invaders is gorse bush, recognisa-

ble by its distinctive yellow flowers. We can help you get rid of them on your property with our 'cut and paste' operation. Just email at the address below and we'll make a date.

Our most recent activity (see picture) has been planting an avenue of she-oak trees along the beach access track near the 5k marker on Dolphin Sands Road. Don't worry, there's still plenty of space for parking and turning. In hopefully not too long a time, we'll see the fruits of that labour providing a shady welcome to locals and visitors alike.

BENDIGO BANK DECISION TO CLOSE BEACONSFIELD AGENCY

It is disappointing that Bendigo Bank has made the decision to close its agency, two years after it worked closely with the community to open the service.

When the only bank at Beaconsfield closed its doors in 2020, the community really rallied to find a solution to fill the void left by the service.

Beaconsfield H Hardware has done a fantastic job over this time to cater for the community with its good, old-fashioned face to face service.

It is concerning that banks are choosing to abandon rural and regional parts of the state in a bid to make people go online to transact with their money and accounts.

Bendigo Bank has made the decision nationally to close some of its agencies, with Sheffield-Railton District and Port Sorell already closed meaning people will need to travel to visit a branch.

In some instances, these communities are home to a number of ageing Tasmanians with little to no online experience who just want to talk through their concerns face to face with someone they know and trust.

I encourage Bendigo Bank to reconsider its decision to close this agency and provide an exemption to keep this service available to the community.

MINISTER STREET **CANNOT BURY LO-CAL GOVERNMENT** REPORT

Today marks 5 weeks of silence from Minister for Local Government Nic Street on using the Local Government Act to force council amalgamations.

We know Minister Street has been sitting on the latest report since Friday and is yet to release it to the public.

We hold serious concerns that the Minister will attempt to release the report late on Thursday afternoon before the Easter Break in order to avoid any scrutiny from the media and community.

This sort of behaviour would, unfortunately, be expected from Jeremy Rockliff's Government. Over the past fortnight alone we've seen another one of his Ministers, Madeleine Ogilvie, attempt to avoid scrutiny over extremely serious issues in her racing and cyber security portfolios, rather than be transparent and open.

It raises the question, what is in the report? And why is Nic Street holding up the process?

I am calling on Minister Street to release the report today.

Tasmanians are rightfully concerned with what is going on in the Local Government sector, and now is not the time to be withholding information.




