At the old quarry at Wye River Conservation Area, a mountain of tyres and piles of domestic waste were collected, painting the bleak portrait of illegal dumping.

According to David Tucker, Wye River event organiser and member of the East Coast

Catchments Steering Committee, "The quarry clean up highlighted the problem of illegal dumping and the need for agencies to work together to ensure this

dumping does not continue. The quarry is a good rest point for travellers, and it is disappointing to think that this is the impression people will be left with. It just isn't the way we should treat our bushland areas. We need to encourage everyone to do the right thing."

Committee Chair Howard Colvin said, "The East Coast Catchment Steering Committee is working with community and stakeholders across land tenures to maintain and improve our biodiversity, land, water and coast. The Great East Coast Clean Up is an opportunity for us to bring different stakeholders together to tackle issues such as illegal dumping."

"We are all volunteers who are passionate about the place and the natural values that

make this area such an incredible place to live", he said.

Organised by the Landscape Recovery Foundation, the Great East Coast Clean Up saw 20 clean up events up and down the coast. "A big shout out to the Spring Bay Ramblers and Friends of Triabunna Re

serves who organised and attended a range of events giving lots of people the opportunity to join in", Howard said. "Of course, It would be fantastic if we didn't need to ask volunteers to clean up other people's rubbish. I call on everyone on the east coast to encourage others in their community to do the right thing!"

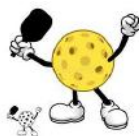

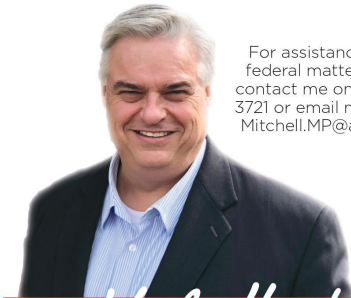

To The Editorial Team

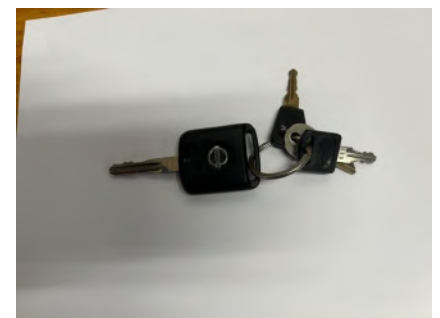

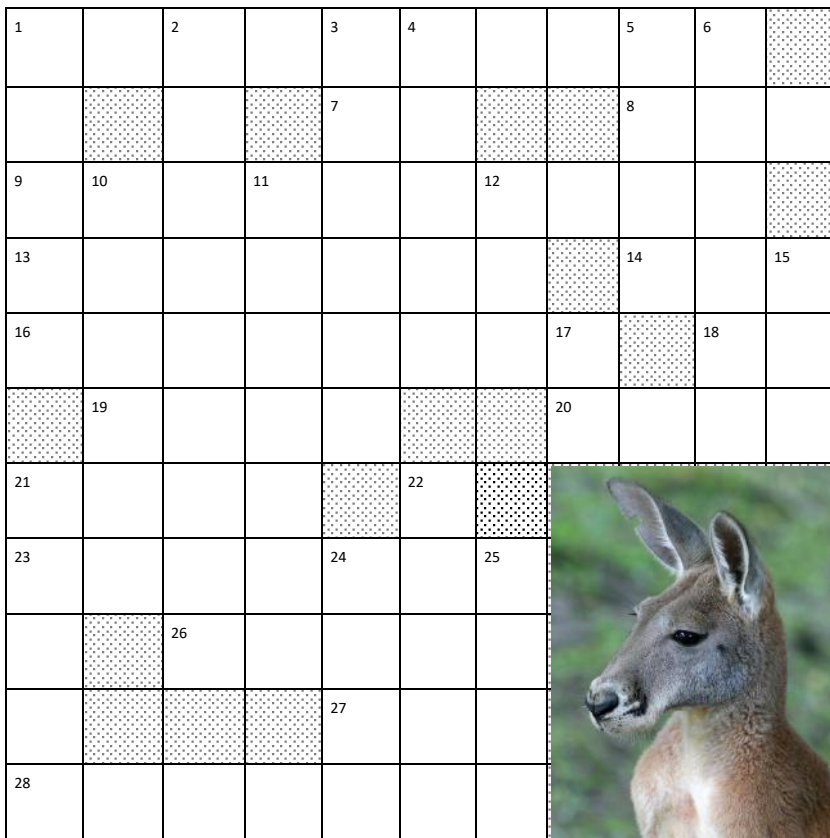

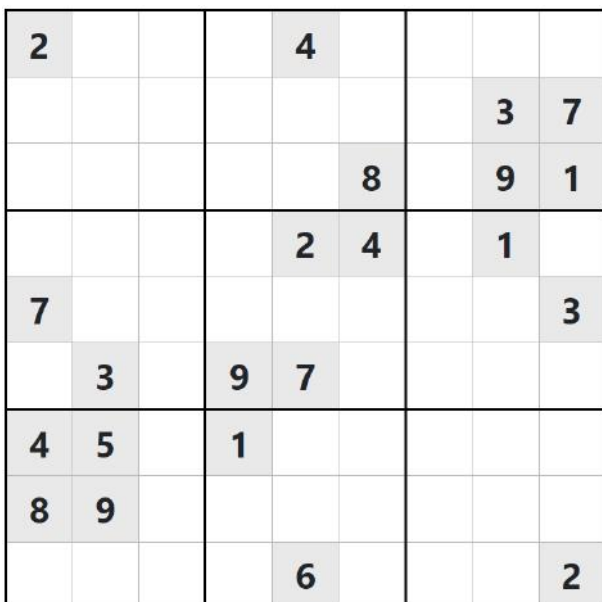

TASMANIA WINTER FORECAST SUMMARY: ISSUED 1ST JUNE

- Northern and eastern Tasmania are likely to have below average rainfall this winter.
- The northern half of the state has at least twice the normal chance of unusually low rainfall.
