less than expected. In other locations, larger amounts of waste proved more disappointing. Nothing was too big for the volunteers, who seized the moment to demonstrate their commitment to looking after our

natural areas – beaches, bushland and parklands.

At the old quarry at Wye River Conserva-

tion Area, a mountain of tyres and piles of domestic waste were collected, painting the bleak portrait of illegal dumping.

According to David Tucker, Wye River event organiser and member of the East Coast

Catchments Steering Committee, "The quarry clean up highlighted the problem of illegal dumping and the need for agencies to work together to ensure this dumping does not continue. The quarry is a good rest point for travellers, and it is disappointing to think that this is the impression people will be left with. It just isn't the way we should treat our bushland areas. We need to encourage everyone to do the right thing."

Committee Chair Howard Colvin said, "The East Coast Catchment Steering Committee is working with community and stakeholders across land tenures to maintain and improve our biodiversity, land, water and coast. The Great East Coast Clean Up is an opportunity for us to bring different stakeholders together to tackle issues such as illegal dumping."
