"If we were staying in a motel or something, we would really struggle financially, so staying at Marillac House is really tremendous," he said.

"We can bring family members down too, which is great because we can all be in the same place. That really helps you survive the situation because you have family members and friends around."

Marillac House Hobart is located on the corner of Murray Street and Bathurst Street, placing it in the centre of the Hobart CBD and only a five-minute walk away from the Royal Hobart Hospital and a range of other medical services.

"People love the location," Manager of Marillac House Hobart Sarah Thomas said.

"There is a chemist right behind us, the hospitals and outpatient clinics are only a five-minute walk away and Woolworths is on the way, so everything is nearby."

Residents are able to comfortably stay in their rooms or spend time in the public areas of the house where they can meet other residents.

"Everybody else that is here is in the same situation as you," Ms Thomas said. "So, people swap stories and help people find their way around Hobart and get used to staying here."

Marillac House Hobart has been operated by the Society since early 2024, while Marillac House Launceston has been operating at a similarly convenient central location in the north for almost two decades.





## TACKLE SERRATED TUSSOCK BEFORE IT TAKES OVER

Serrated tussock (*Nassella trichotoma*) is a perennial (long-lived) tussock-forming grass, considered one of the worst weeds in Australia. An aggressively invasive grass, it outcompetes native grasses, is unpalatable to almost all stock, and capable of reducing pasture productivity by up to 95%.

Serrated tussock is mainly spread by wind. Flower heads break off whole, and may be carried by the wind, or water or machinery, for many kilometres. It has been estimated that one hectare of serrated tussock infestation can produce 500 million seeds every year.

#### Positive identification

Similar to several of Tasmania's native tussock grasses (Poa species), it is frequently overlooked until it begins to flower in late spring, after which a large number of purple florets give it a distinctly purple appearance.

Seedlings may appear at any time of year, but most germinate in autumn or winter. Young plants are upright and densely tufted with tightly in-rolled leaves. Leaf leaves are bright green and the leaf sheaths (which wrap around the base of the leaves) are a whitish colour, and more slender and closely packed than those seen in the native tussocks. The leaves feel rough (or serrated) if the finger and thumb are drawn down the blade.

#### Winter is the time to inspect for tussock

Council is aware of several properties across Glamorgan Spring Bay with local infestations and, although not yet widespread, it may have already made its way onto your land.

In frost-prone areas, the green tussocks are bleached a golden yellow to white colour by frost during late autumn and winter. The change in colour makes the plants easier to spot in a paddock, making now a good time to do a survey of your land.

Serrated tussock is a costly weed to have on your property, especially when it becomes established.

Controlling serrated tussock before the plant goes to seed in spring is critical to prevent further spread, lost productivity and increased control requirements.

#### Weed management - it's your responsibility

It is your responsibility to control serrated tussock on your land. Serrated tussock is a declared weed under Tasmania's *Weed Management Act 1999*. Failure to remove it from your property could result in legal action. Council will be undertaking property inspections for serrated tussock in the coming months so now is the time inspect your property and make a treatment plan.

If you are uncertain as to whether a plant you have found is serrated tussock, collect a sample of it in a sealed bag, take note of the location, and contact Biosecurity




