ANNUAL GIVING PROGRAM 2023

At the August meeting, Swansea Online Access Centre Committee met and discussed amongst other things the applicants of the Annual Giving Program.

This year we had a record number of applicants, with a record amount of funds needed.

Applicants were from various Glamorgan-Spring Bay towns, not just Swansea but also Bicheno and Triabunna. There were many first-time applicants this year all with worthwhile projects and associated requests and we are hopeful that these grants will provide the assistance needed.

Next year's grants will see a change in name and content with a limit on the size of the grants available. It was felt that the GSBC Small Community Grants Program is more appropriate for smaller projects & local programs, so a limit of \$1000 has been instigated, but higher amounts will be taken into consideration if funds are available.

VIETNAM VETERAN'S DAY 18™ AUGUST 2023.

Despite the impending rain which held off until almost the end of the ceremony, 30 plus people attended the recreation of the replica Long Tan Cross on the lawn of the East Coast Heritage Centre, to mark the $50^{\rm th}$ anniversary of the official end of the Vietnam war in 1973.

The form made by the Swansea Men's shed was situated in the triangle of the rose garden and with incredible reinforcing designed and supplied by Dale Arnol , and Cement and gravel mix from Phil Barker , Marc Alloin was able to start mixing and pouring the cement to set the reinforcement at 10:45.

After the opening remarks and a stirring rendition of "I was only nineteen" sung by Steve Kenny and a military historian's view from Dr Tyquin, Veterans, Family Members the Student Representative Council of Swansea Primary, the RSL Ladies Auxiliary, Swansea R.S.L. Sub Branch, Councillor McSweeney and community members and those affected by



the Vietnam War were supplied with concrete by Marc Alloin to complete the cross.



Recollections of Vietnam veterans were read and the service concluded with the Ode of Remembrance, followed by a One Minute Silence and with rain starting to fall the National Anthem was sung and refreshments were offered in the Swansea R.S.L.

The replica Long Tan cross has to dry and set now for a few weeks before the form can be removed and preparations made to install the Replica cross with a Brass plaque acknowledging the duty and service of our Vietnam veterans. The East Coast Heritage Museum is hosting a display of Vietnam memorabilia in the War Memorial room until the end of August.
