## THE FUTURE OF SWANSEA, SPRING-BAY & ALL TASMANIAN ONLINE ACCESS CENTRES IN QUESTION.

At the Tasmanian Parliament's Estimate Committee hearing on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> of September the follow exchange was held: **"Transcript from Education Minister 8<sup>th</sup> of September 2021**

**Re on-line access centre funding.**

**Ms DOW - Minister, the PESRAC report cited the importance of online access centres, particularly for building digital capacity across our regional areas across Tasmania.**

**Are online access centres funded through Libraries Tasmania as a grant in this Budget, and will online access centres be funded beyond 2023 by your Government?**

**Ms COURTNEY - I'll just make some broad comments to start with. Having online access is incredibly important. We know that having digital literacy and access to online learning is critical. It also flows through a different portfolio, so we're seeing a partnership between TasTAFE and Libraries Tasmania for online access for students to be able to learn.**

**Through that, we're looking strategically at the infrastructure that we do have across government. Libraries obviously have a very good physical presence in lots of places across Tasmania, including the Bass Strait islands, so we're looking at how we can utilise those facilities through the investment for TasTAFE, so we can have smart investing of government resources into those online spaces and online centres.**

**I am happy for Ms Jack talk through the funding.**

**Ms JACK - As the minister has said, the online access centres are really important in terms of the broad digital inclusion approach we have in Libraries Tasmania. The grants that are provided to the Community-Managed Online Access Centres total \$450 000 per annum. They are distributed among those community-managed OACs, and spread around the state in various locations. At the moment they're guaranteed until the end of June 2022.**

**Ms DOW - The second part of my question was around the extension of the funding beyond 2023. Can you confirm that please?**

**Ms COURTNEY - Clearly, the Government is very committed to these facilities. I'm not in a position at the moment to put on record the quantum of funding, but in future Budgets we'll look to how we can do that.**

**I've mentioned the relationship we have with Libraries, and with TasTAFE in particular, so we need to be looking at how we can implement more provision of online access around Tasmania. This really does go to broader government initiatives around how we increase adult literacy. As we've seen and talked about earlier, we also have the literacy panel that has been stood up through Jenny Gale, the secretary of DPAC. We'll be looking for them to provide not just literacy in our schools, but literacy more broadly. Libraries have played - and continue to play - in the provision of all sorts of programs, like 26TEN, a range of different in-reach services to different facilities, including I think the prisons.**

**They are a good model for getting that community reach and engagement. That interface.**

**Ms DOW - Just to be clear, minister, you will be funding them past 2023?**

**Ms COURTNEY - It's my expectation, given the value that they provide. However, I'm not in a position today to provide the detail of that. Considering that I have other funding through other portfolios that are looking around online access, we'll work through the provision of that funding, and then look to what would be appropriate in the future. ## WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR THE FUTURE OF SOAC & GOBCNews?

Our initial reading and the interpretation by some of the committee members was that as from 30<sup>th</sup> June 2022 SOAC and all the other Online Access Centres in Tasmania will close never to return under a Liberal Government. That they will be integrated into the libraries in Bicheno open 5 days a week alternating Morning & Afternoon, Swansea open 2 days a week Tuesday & Thursday and Sorell open 5 1/2 days a week.

The librarians may or may not have time to help you with your queries, printing of documents and help in accessing Govt. departments, however the online centres, their volunteers and coordinators will not be available.

We think, at this stage, we shall be able to continue the newsletter, however this will depend on the advertisers being committed, as if at any stage we find the newsletter not being profitable, then it will close without notification

As we have only just found this out, we shall keep you informed.

### SEASPEAK ARTICLE SPRING ISSUE 2021

In the Spring edition of SeaSpeak, the GSBC General Manager, Mr G Ingham, finally reveals that GSBC has finally met the requirements of the Performance Improvement Direction, issued on 23/07/21 by the then Minister for Local Government, Mr Mark Shelton; thus ensuring compliance with the Local Govt Act. Mr Ingham then proceeded to espouse the benefits of the introduction of the "AAV" formula for calculating rates for GSBC residents:

The 10 year Strategic Community Plan

Budget for the 2021/22 Capital program was highlighted as important initiatives

The Asset Management Plan was also highlighted as a crucial component of managing critical assets in the municipality.

On the surface, it would appear that: a lot of discussions have taken place on the dire financial plight of GSBC hence the PID from the local govt minister 2020. There were 3 important stakeholders that were to be kept informed on progress of the PID.

The Local Government Minister;  
The Director of Local Government;  
and

The Ratepayers of GSBC.

All the stakeholders were to be kept informed of all steps being taken to comply with the PID. This was to be done via progress reports on matters discussed and decisions made or proposed. This matter was not referred to or put up for discussion at the recent Community Connect session in Swansea.

Would the GSBC please provide me with copies of all the progress reports of the PID process that resulted in the introduction of the "AAV" formula.

I hasten to add, I have noted the General

Manager's reference to "improvements" to the GSBC website and making it "easier to navigate".

Finally I ask the simple question: "How much extra does it cost the GSBC to provide services to a \$1 million principal residence versus a \$250,000 principal residence"? (I hasten to add that we do not rent our residence or rooms in it, thus we do not gain an income from use of our property.

### MEREDITH BRIDGE PROPOSAL

Over the past few weeks two letters appeared in this newsletter concerning a project that would benefit the local community. Not a single councillor has taken the time to respond while the mayor is missing in action. Last year, before being elected, the mayor stated he was committed among other things, to 'supporting local jobs, tourism'. Somehow this now does not seem to ring true.

If councillors support the project they should say so, equally if they are opposed to it they should publicly state their reasons. Twenty years ago council might have gotten away with sitting on their hands and hoping the issue would go away, but this is 2021. Lack of input or participation by our elected representatives simply fuels calls for administrators to take over councils.

The proposal is a simple one: to seek council support to submit an application to build a pedestrian/cyclist bridge across the Meredith River using state and federal grant funding.

If a similar (but bigger) bridge at St. Helens (part of a \$2.1 million federally funded project) was approved by the Break of Day Council in March 2020 cannot our council do the same for Swansea?



The Department of State Growth is proposing a Road Widening and Alignment project South of Bicheno and want to hear from the community. We are asking people to view the plans and provide feedback on the proposed works from the S Bends known locally as "Dead Horse Hill", to the Waste Transfer Station junction on the southern side of Bicheno.

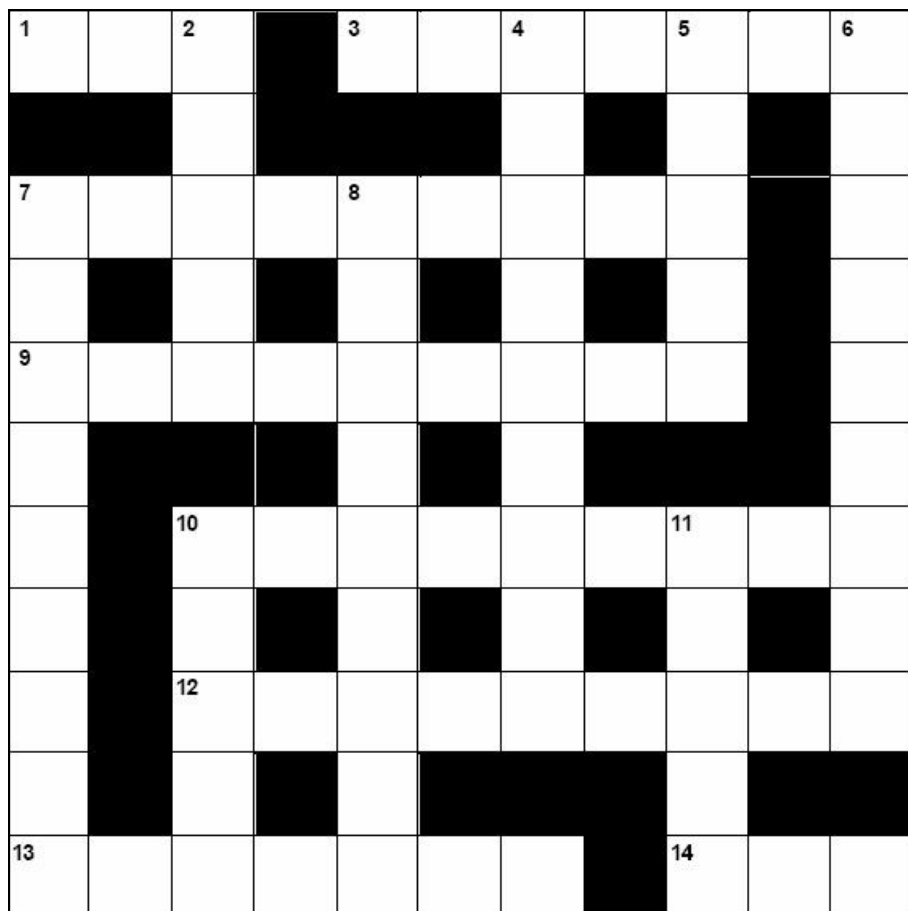

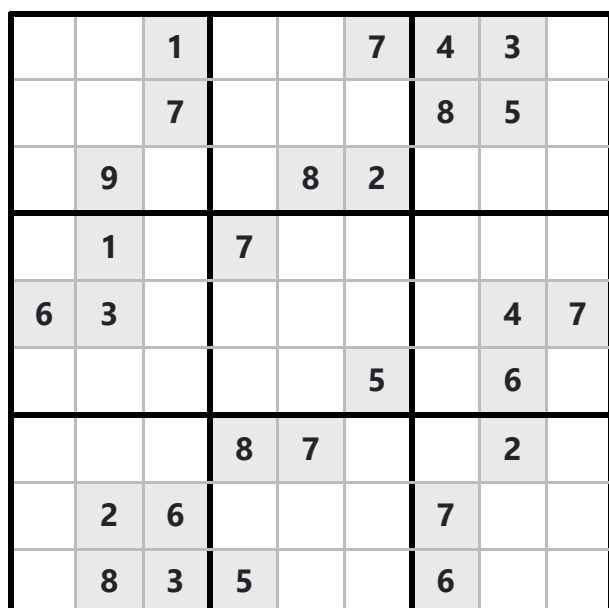
