COMMUNITY BANK UPDATE

The Board is continuing its practice of meeting in townships the Bank services and engaging with local businesses and community members. The July meeting was held in Bicheno.

The Board was privileged to tour Waubs Harbour Distillery, founded by Rob, Tim and Bec Polmear. The business has been quietly operating (and ageing that beautiful whisky) for several years, and anticipates launching its first whisky release in 2023.

Waubs Harbour Distillery has made a significant investment in Bicheno and has renovated the old oyster shed at the gulch, where it now practices the art and alchemy of making good whisky. Having been treated to a tasting, the Board speaks from experience!

After the tour and its meeting, the Board hosted about 50 guests at the Farm Shed, with lovely local wines and delicious catering by Stella Laker. We are lucky to have such wonderful local businesses to make these events a success.

Suzanne Turner, Senior Branch Manager, provided an overview and update about

the Bank's products and services. Presentations were made by two recent recipients of the Bank's community grants about the projects funded and ongoing activities. Tom Spykers, the principal of the Bicheno Primary School, and the Alex Graham, President of the School Association, spoke about the school's playground equipment project. Pam Troode, the chair of the Bicheno Skate Park Committee, provided an overview of progress on the skate park project.

BUTLER CALLS ON ONLINE ACCESS CENTRE FUNDING GUARANTEE

Labor Member for Lyons, Jen Butler MP, has called on the government to guarantee funding for Online Access Centre's past 2022.

Currently, funding runs out at the end of June 2022, with funding after this date uncertain.

Ms Butler said it was appalling that the future of Online Access Centre's was up in the air.

"I was extremely disappointed to hear that Online Access Centre's have no guaranteed funding past June 2022," Ms Butler said.

"In 2018 Online Access Centres faced closure and once again we have learnt that the future is uncertain.

"Online Access Centre's provide vital digital services and programs to Tasmanian communities and their importance cannot be understated."

Ms Butler said the revelations were unearthed in Budget Estimates in September. "Labor asked a number of questions to Education Minister Sarah Courtney around the funding certainty of Online Access Centres and it was indicated that funding is only guaranteed until the end of June 2022.

"Minister Courtney was quite supportive of the centres and I call on her to guarantee funding beyond 2022.

"The services Online Access Centres provide are far too important to lose."

Federal MP Brian Mitchell says he's honoured to be re-endorsed to run for Labor in the seat of Lyons at the next federal election, due in 2022.

The announcement coincides with the 5th anniversary of his first speech to parliament.

"It's an honour every day to serve as the Member for Lyons and I look forward to seeking re-election," Mr Mitchell said. "I had another read of my first speech and everything I said in it holds true today: more jobs, better health, integrity, decency.

Diane Elizabeth Thank you for your comments. The majority of Online Access Centres are funded by the Tas Govt. The grant that Swansea receives is \$20k p/a over three years ending 30th June 2022. The Govt is withdrawing this funding. The Govt also supply the computers, wifi & internet access. Without this funding the OACs would not be able to operate as an online centre. Swansea (SOAC) would not have the funds to continue to offer the services that are available now. The entity Swansea Online Access Centre INC. would become redundant. SOAC publishes the Great Oyster Bay Community Newsletter (GOBC). GOBC is not a legal entity and does not exist other than as a publication of SOAC. My point about GOBC closing once it did not return a profit, was that the volunteers would not be willing, nor able to fund its publication. GOBC is currently free because of the support of the paid advertisers.

BUSHFIRE MITIGATION IN DOLPHIN SANDS

The Dolphin Sands Ratepayers Association (DSRA) would like to thank the current management team at Glamorgan Spring Bay Council (GSBC) for clearing the roadside verges. Fire safety is an ongoing concern for our community and we're grateful to have this concern allayed somewhat.

Dolphin Sands is a bushfire-prone area with no Tasmania Fire Service (TFS) 'nearby safer places'. To get to safety during a bushfire, residents and visitors must use the road. Clearing the verges makes this safer. It also makes road use safer for emergency services. We are deeply appreciative of our emergency service personnel and feel that it's important to support them as much as possible. Clear verges also provide pull-off areas, greater visibility for people exiting properties and will hopefully reduce roadkill.

The DSRA encourages our members to review their bushfire plans and prepare their properties for bushfire. In the last two years, we've successfully applied for two lots of funding to support our members to maintain their defendable zone and clear beside their driveways. We'll continue to look for funding opportunities for this cause.

In the last few years, the TFS has conducted fuel-reduction burns in Dolphin Sands. We're hopeful that the reduced fuel load from the combination of TFS, GSBC and DSRA efforts will help reduce the severity and impact of bushfire in Dolphin Sands.

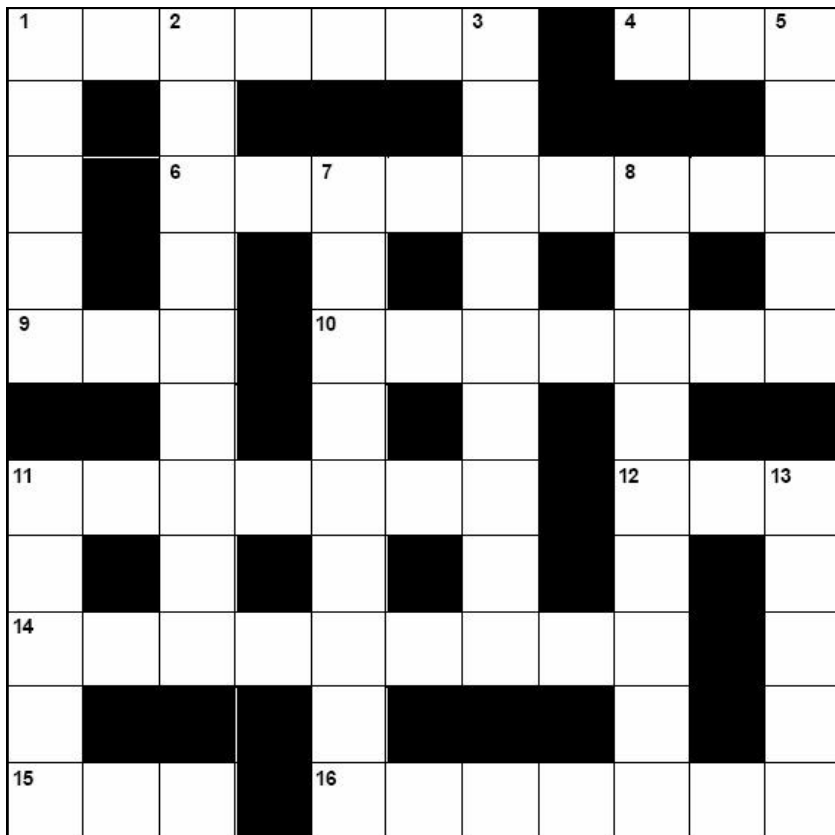

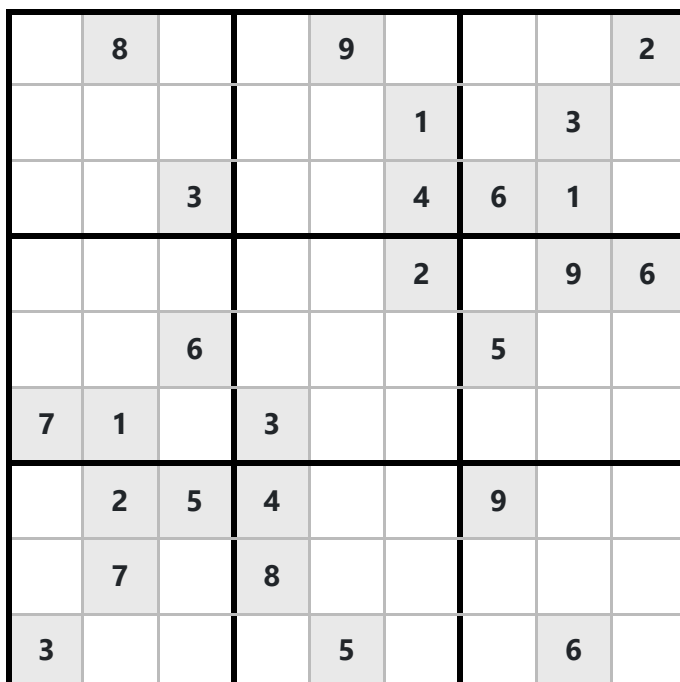
