SUPPORTING HEALTH WORKERS ON THE EAST COAST

The Tasmanian Labor Party has announced a state-wide regional health policy as part of their Right Priorities Plan, with the May Shaw Health Centre in Swansea listed to benefit from these investments.

The plan highlights the need for more resources for the May Shaw Health Centre, with the Labor Party pledging to employ more staff to increase service. Among those staff increases is the promise to employ 5 more nurse practitioners, as well as an additional rural generalist for the East Coast.

Nurse practitioners and rural generalists provide a dynamic range of skills and services, including experience, expertise and authority to diagnose and treat people of all ages with a variety of acute or chronic health conditions.

Labor Leader Rebecca White announced the health plan to deal with the chronic shortages Tasmanians have been experiencing in their communities.

“We want Tasmanians to be able to access healthcare close to where they live,” Ms White said.

“That’s why a Labor government will make a significant investment in our regional hospitals and health facilities to make sure they can provide enhanced 24/7 emergency care and a wider range of primary health services.”

“Our dedicated health workers are the backbone of the health system. Rural generalists will be able to work as part of a multidisciplinary team of nurse practition-

ers, who can provide diverse and valuable services in regional areas in particular.”

“Under Labor’s plan, \$14.9 million per year will be invested per year to employ 90 nurse practitioners, 18 rural generalists, 36 nurses and 5 clinical nurse educators, guaranteeing that Tasmanians can receive care closer to where they live.

“These nurses will be part of a multidisciplinary team, working collaboratively with General Practice across our regional and rural communities.”

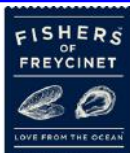

FAQs on the Voice

Will the Voice make a difference?

YES. Giving Indigenous communities a say on issues that affect them will help the Parliament to make better decisions to improve the lives of First Nations people. It is also a huge step toward Reconciliation and uniting us as a nation.

Why don't all Indigenous people support the Voice?

Like any group, not all Indigenous people agree with the Voice being a first step. Polling*, however, has shown 80% of Indigenous people do. The Uluru Statement, which asked for the Voice, had 250 signatures representing more than 100 indigenous communities from right across Australia.

Why do we need a Voice when there are Indigenous politicians?

Politicians are voted in and out. The Voice will be in the Constitution and this gives certainty that First Nation's peoples will have a say on issues that affect them, no matter who is in government.

FAQs on the Voice

Will it create a string of court battles?

No. Numerous top legal minds have confirmed that how the Parliament chooses to act on the advice of the Voice cannot be challenged in court. A parliamentary committee that examined the Voice proposal found it not only fit for purpose, but that it would *enhance* Australia's systems of governance and laws. [Scan the QR code for the full report.]



Don't we need much more detail?

The voice is a model. Exactly how it will be set up will be decided by the Parliament, but a detailed, 260-page report that has been written by Indigenous people will serve as a guide. This is called the Langton-Carma report.

Why not Treaty and Truth first?

The Voice is the **first step** in response to the Uluru Statement from the Heart, but it's not the only step. Treaty and truth-telling will follow.

Several states, including Tasmania, have started the treaty process, but this will take time. Once set up, the Voice can start its work immediately.
