MOBILE SERVICE CENTRE BLUE GUM TRAVELS THROUGH EAST COAST TASMANIA

Tasmanians living in Campbell Town and on the East Coast will be have the opportunity to access important Government Services close to home as the Mobile Service Centre Blue Gum tours the state over the next few weeks.

Blue Gum is one of three trucks in the Mobile Service Centre fleet operated by Services Australia, providing customers assistance with essential government services including Centrelink, Medicare and Child Support.

Liberal Senator for Tasmania Claire Chandler encouraged anyone with questions to head down and talk to the staff aboard Blue Gum.

“When not engaged in emergency response to disaster areas the Mobile Service Centre trucks tour the country to help those living in rural and remote Australia connect to Government services,” Senator Chandler said.

“Staff on board Blue Gum provide friendly face-to-face services, information and provide tailored support to

customers living in regional communities.”

The Australian Government has been supporting rural communities through mobile servicing since November 2006. Minister for Government Services Senator the Hon Linda Reynolds CSC said Mobile Service Centres demonstrate the Government’s commitment to ensuring all Australians get the support they need, no matter where they live, particularly following a natural disaster.

“It’s important that communities in rural and remote areas can access essential government services easily, so they can get on with their lives,” Minister Reynolds said.

“In total, Mobile Service Centres have travelled over 970,000 kilometres since 2006 and have assisted over 166,000 customers in more than 5,400 communities.

“Blue Gum will continue its travel through Tasmania’s East Coast during mid-October to ensure people in these regions can continue to access the services they need in 2021.”

In addition to state tours the trucks have been utilised in 28 emergency responses where crews have spent over 400 days in and around 290 different communities.

All of the services provided on Blue Gum are offered with strict COVID-19 safety precautions in place.
